
If you forgive other people when they sin against you, your heavenly father will also forgive you. But if you do not forgive others their sins, your father will not forgive your sins.

1. Forgiveness is NOT forgetting.




What does it mean to NOT

1. Giving others what God gave us in Christ.




1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and JUST and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness.
