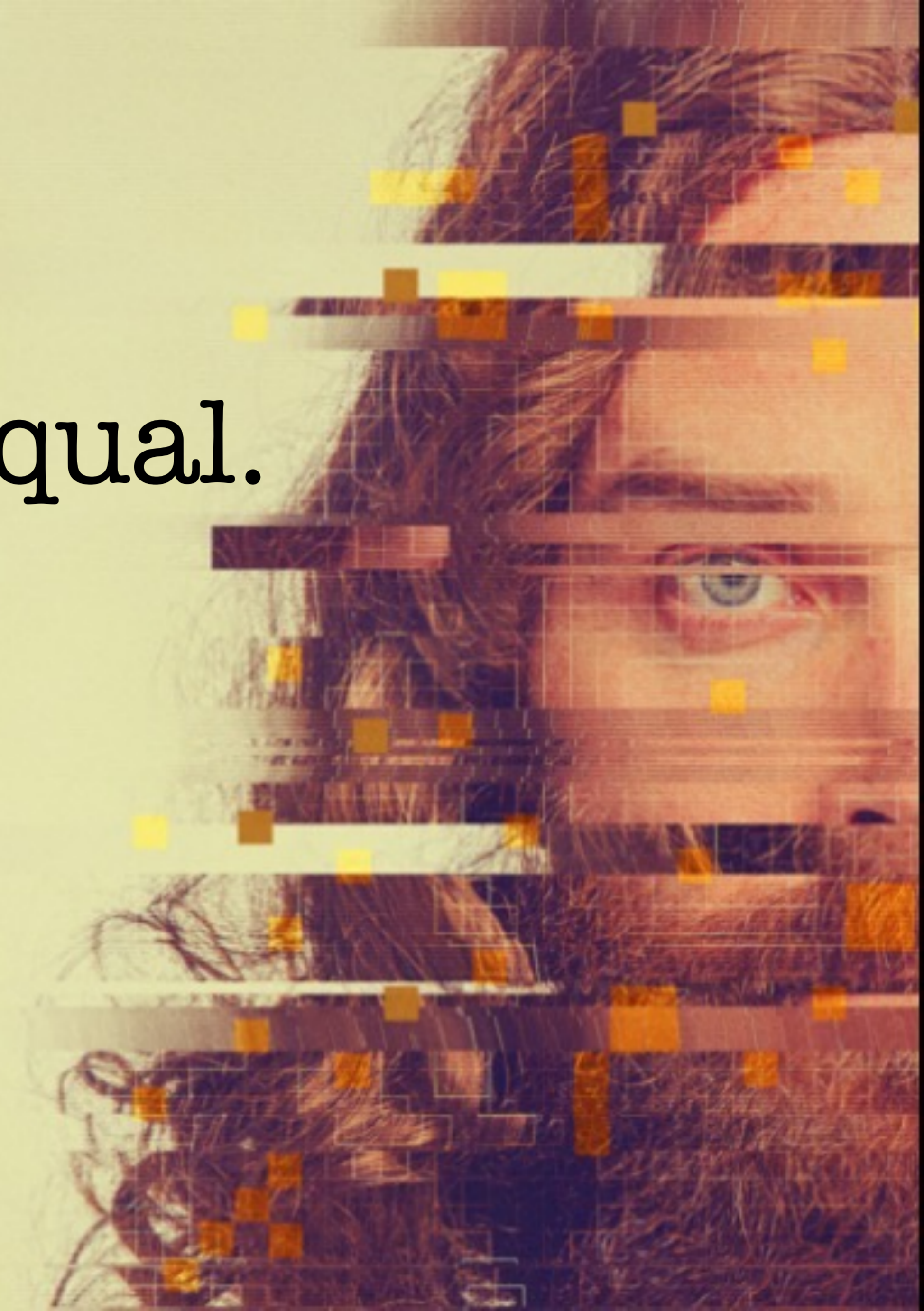




WHO IS JESUS?

Not all guilt is created equal.



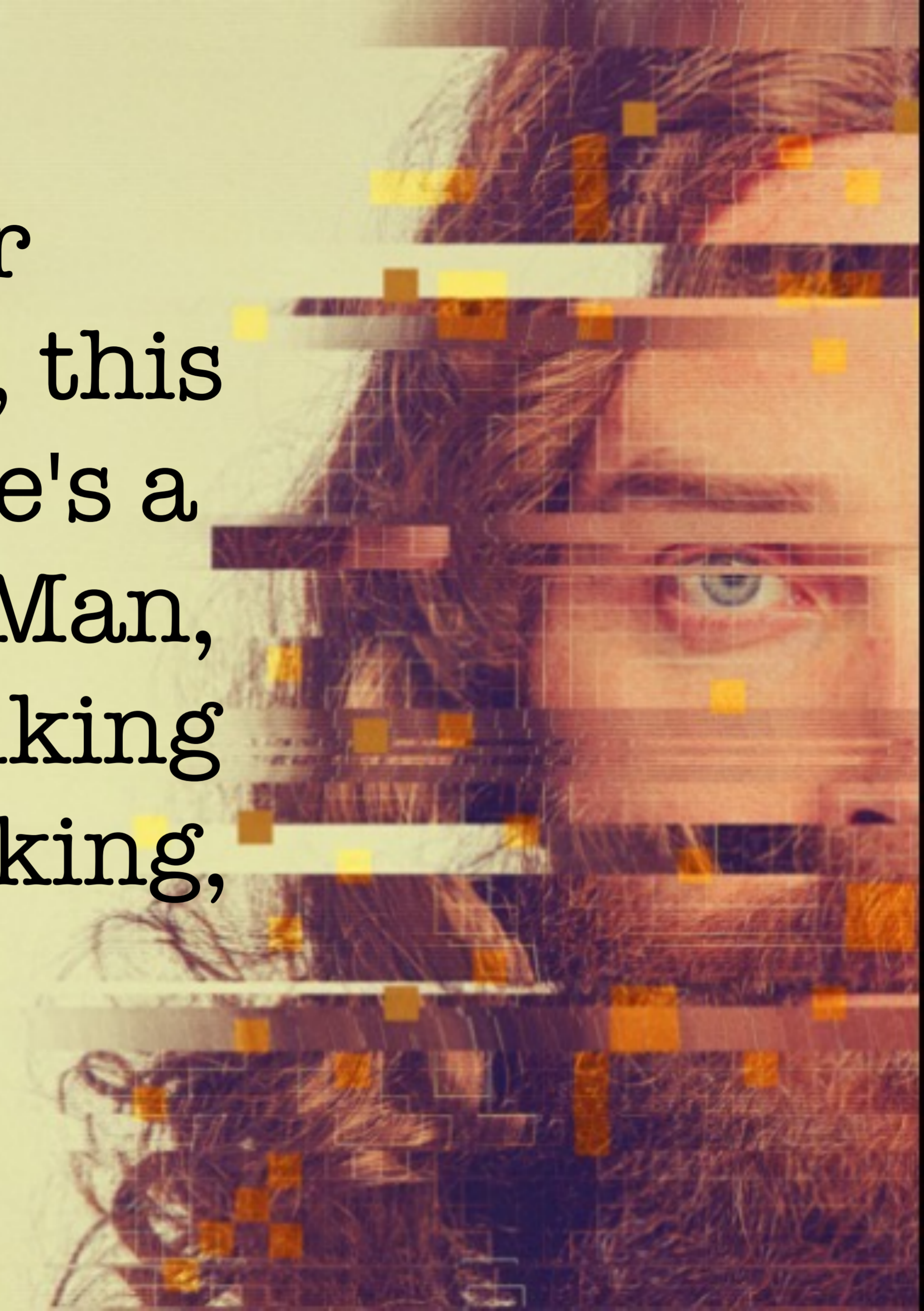
2 Corinthians 7:10_(NIV)
