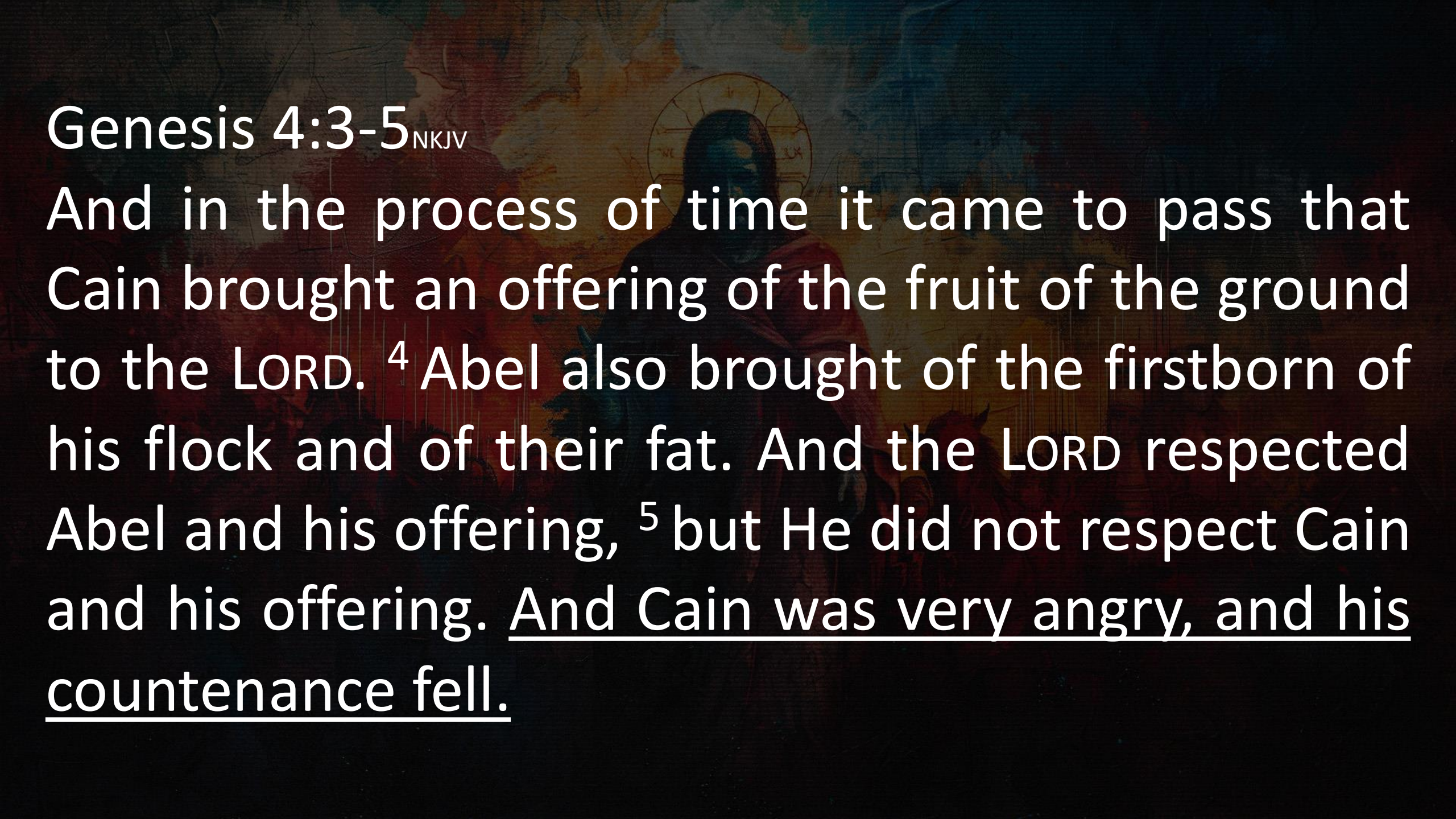




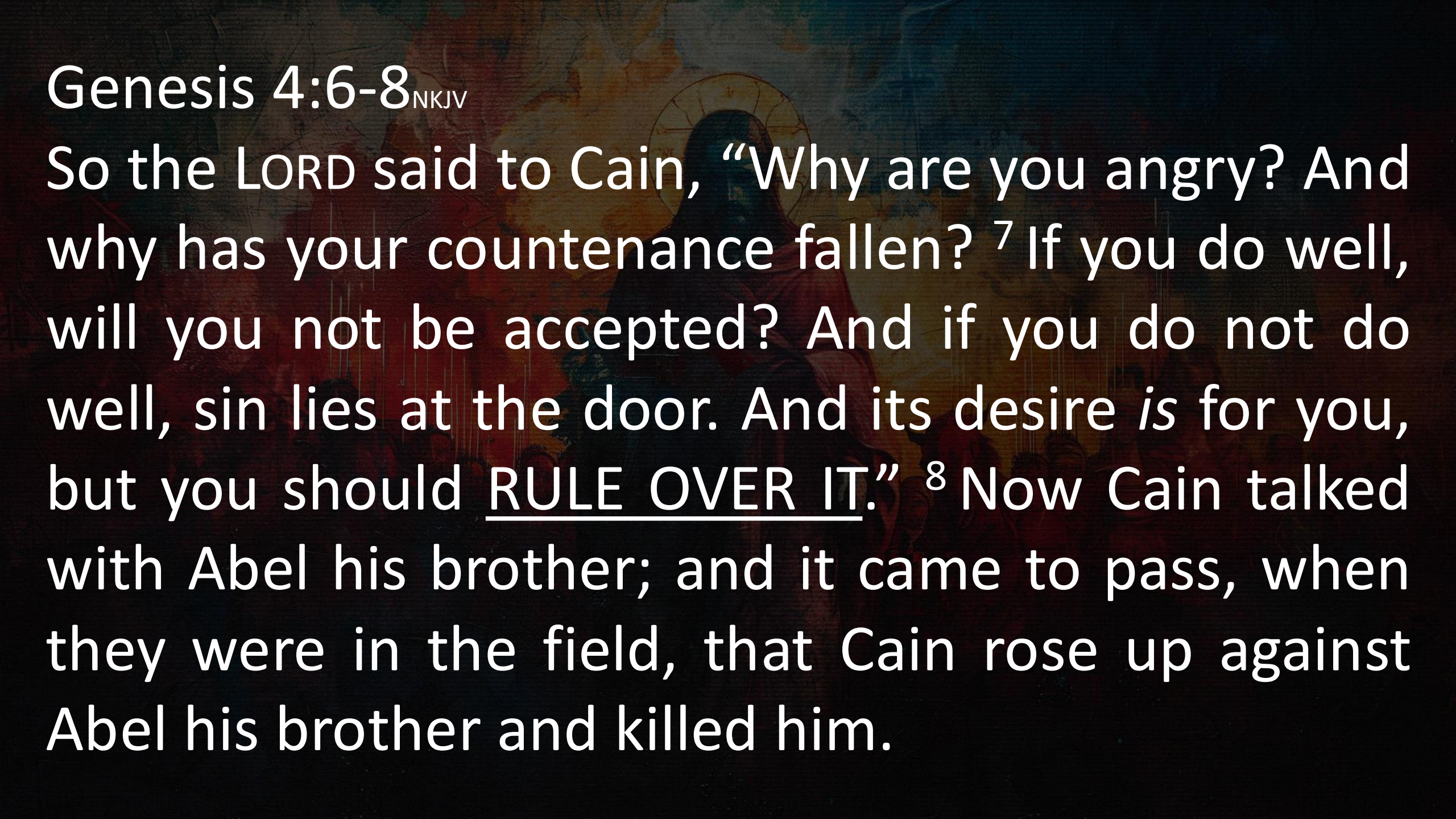

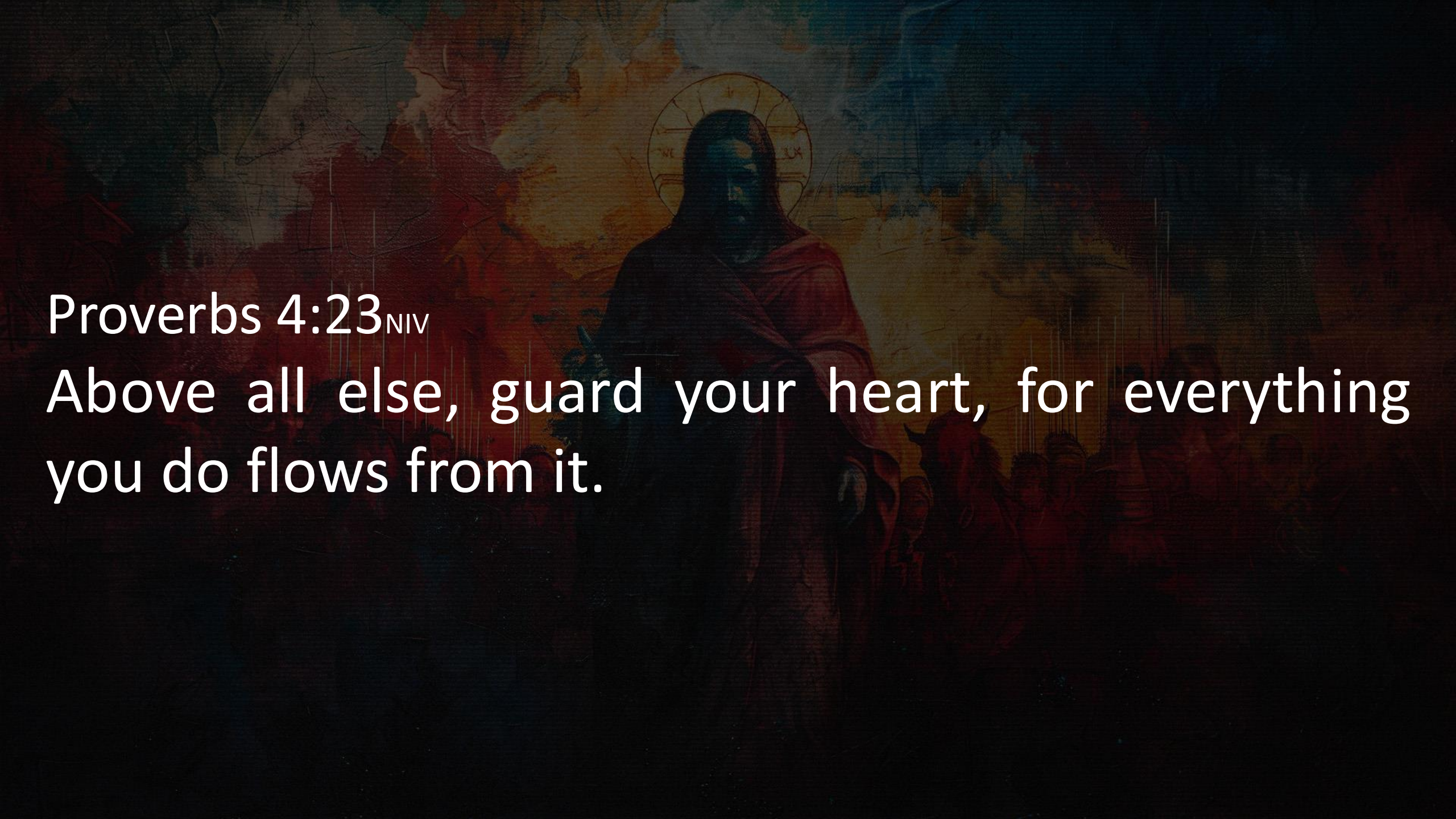


Genesis 4:6-8_{NKJV}

rewrites your personality.

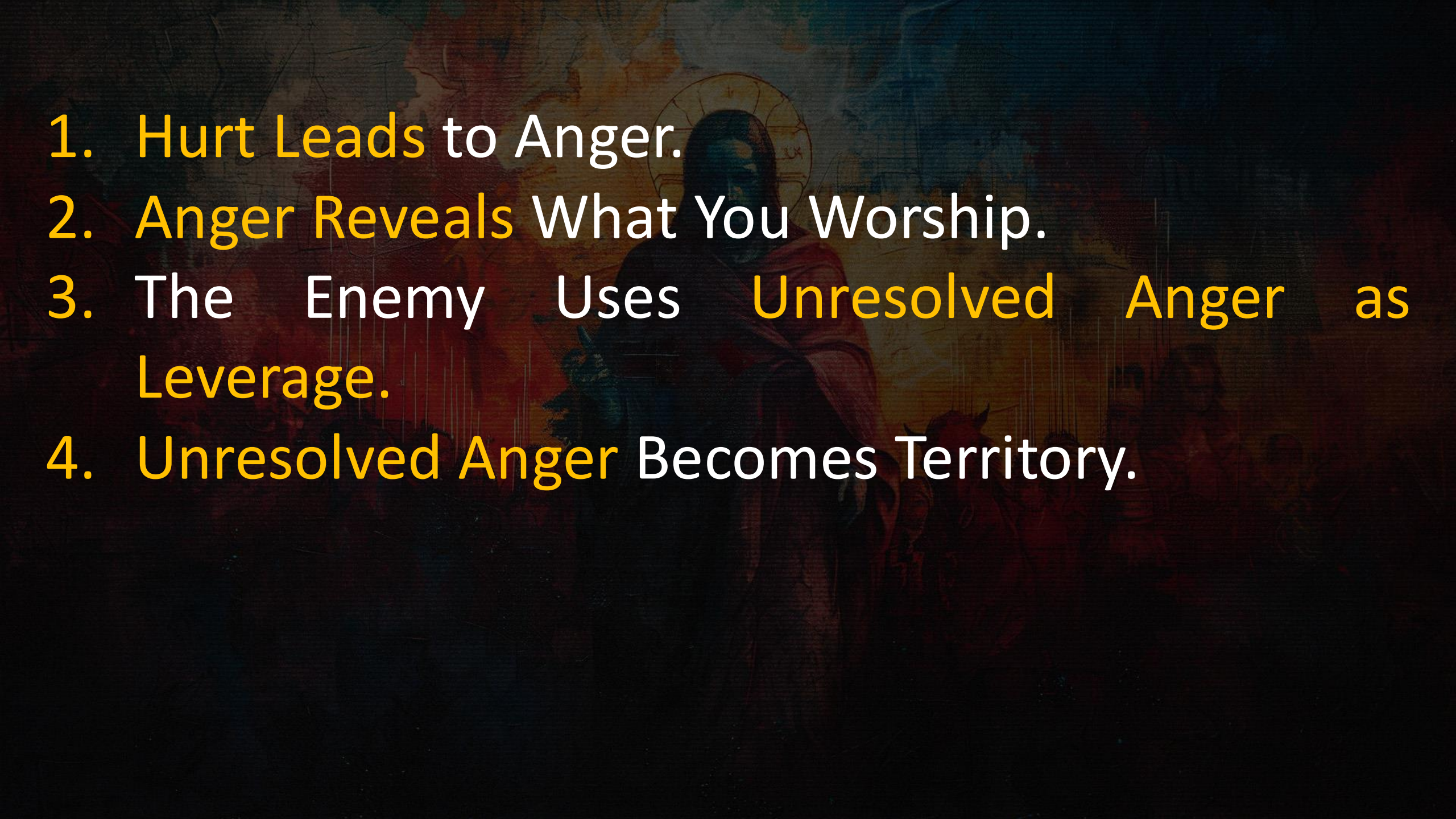


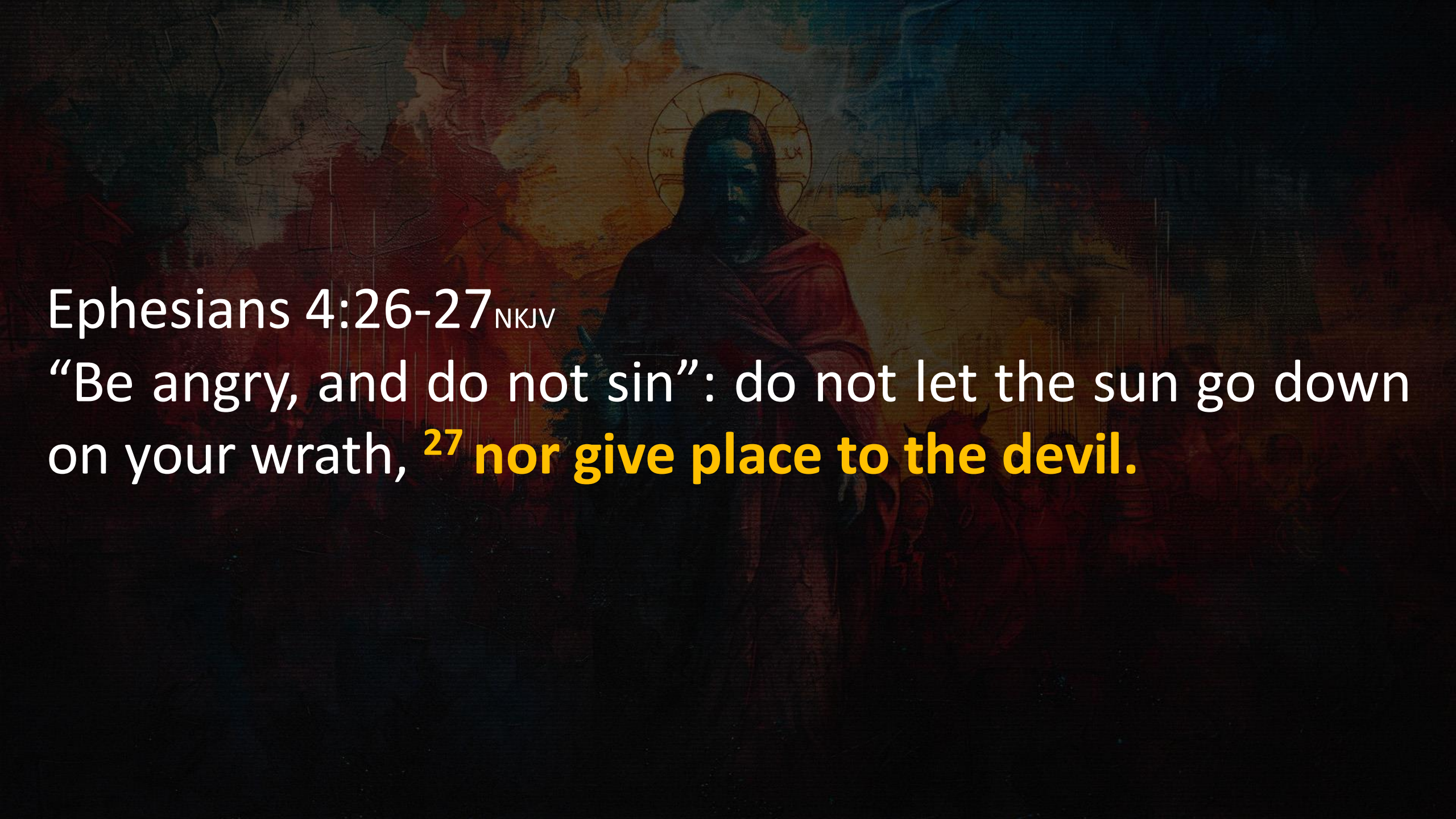
