


Isaiah 43:18–19_(NKJV)






The gift God gives is forgiveness, and no skeletons in your past.

1 John 1:9 (NKJV) If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us of our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness.


Grace is never a license to sin, but the law is never a reason to bury the guilty.
