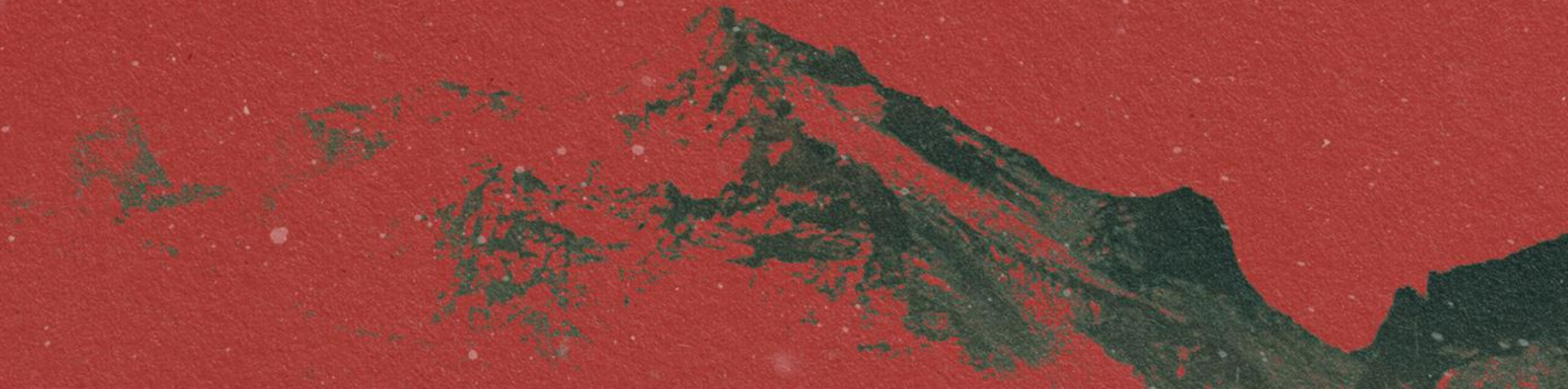

Presence in Greek = **Prosopon**

Meaning: **FACE**

Fellowship is coming into times of
REFRESHING.

Galatians 5:17^{NKJV}

For the flesh lusts against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh;
and these are contrary to one another, so that you do not do the
things that you wish.

Worship in Greek = Proskuneo

Meaning: To kiss towards

Matthew 6:6_{AMP}

But when you pray, go into your most private room, close the door and pray to your Father who is in secret, and your Father who sees [what is done] in secret will reward you.

Isaiah 66:8_{KJV}

...for as soon as Zion travailed, she brought forth her children.

Prayer is Partnership.

Prayer is **CHANGES** things.

Luke 10:2_{NKJV}

Then He said to them, “The harvest truly *is* great, but the laborers *are* few; therefore pray the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest.

To send out in Greek = Ekballo

Meaning: To Cast out or Throw out;
Implies a forceful or urgent
sending

Without a praying church, fruit can be ready
and not harvested and ultimately lost.
