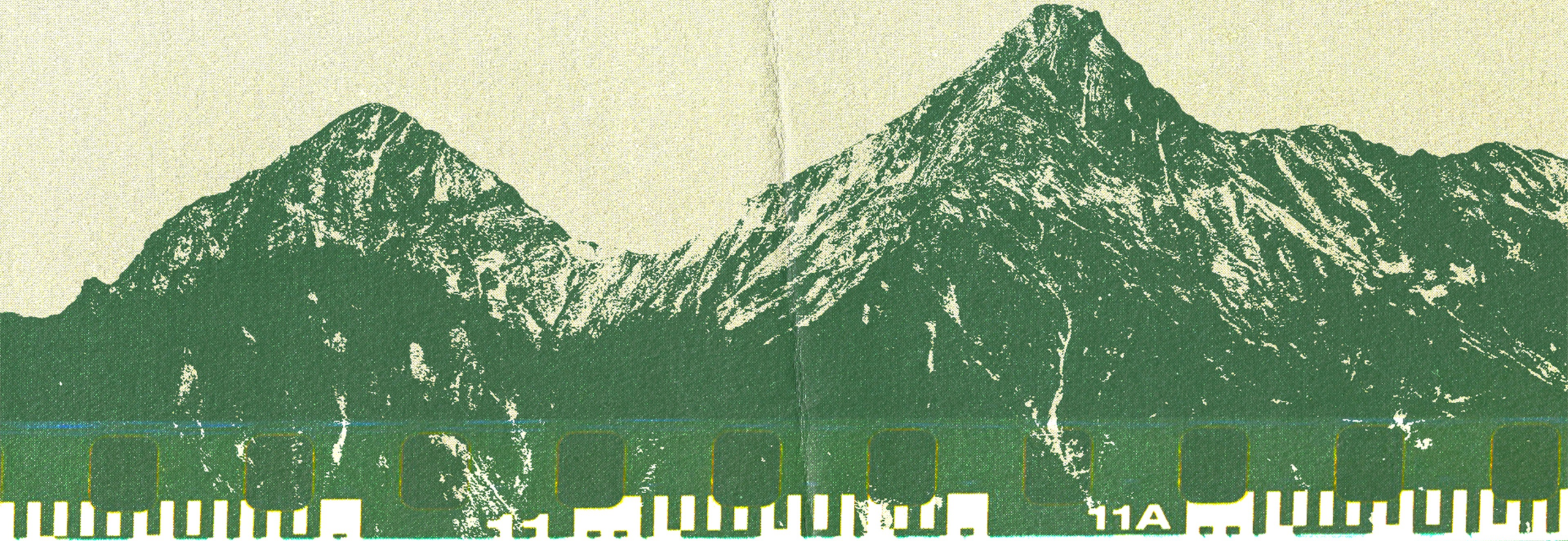


# Preparation

## Joshua 5:9-10<sup>(NKJV)</sup>

Then the LORD said to Joshua, “This day I have rolled away the reproach of Egypt from you.” Therefore the name of the place is called Gilgal to this day.  
<sup>10</sup> Now the children of Israel camped in Gilgal, and kept the Passover on the fourteenth day of the month at twilight on the plains of Jericho.

For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, these are sons of God.

Joshua 5:9<sub>(NKJV)</sub>

Then the LORD said to Joshua, “This day I have rolled away the reproach of Egypt from you.”

God was removing the shame and reproach of Egypt from people who never lived in Egypt.

The shame and reproach of Egypt was generational.



**SHAME** is a tool of the enemy that keeps people out of right **IDENTITY** & **PURPOSE**.

Shame reproduces in the next generation.
