Joshua 5:9-10_(NKJV)

Then the LORD said to Joshua, "This day I have rolled away the reproach of Egypt from you." Therefore the name of the place is called Gilgal to this day. ¹⁰ Now the children of Israel camped in Gilgal, and kept the Passover on the fourteenth day of the month at twilight on the plains of Jericho.

Romans 8:14_(NKJV) For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, these are sons of God.

Joshua 5:9(NKJV) Then the LORD said to Joshua, "This day I have rolled away the <u>reproach</u> of Egypt from you."

God was removing the shame and reproach of Egypt from people who never lived in Egypt.

The shame and reproach of Egypt was generational.

SHAME is a tool of the enemy that keeps people out of right **IDENTITY & PURPOSE**.

Shame reproduces in the next generation.

Joshua 5:9(NKJV) ⁹Then the LORD said to Joshua, "This day I have rolled away the reproach of Egypt from you."

NOT shame on you...SHAME OFF YOU!

We're walking into a Gilgal moment and God is rolling the reproach and shame off you.

Zephaniah 3:19_(NKJV) I will appoint them for praise and fame in every land where they were put to shame.
