



THE HOLY SPIRIT

1 Corinthians 12:4-11

There are diversities of gifts, but the same Spirit. ⁵ There are differences of ministries, but the same Lord. ⁶ And there are diversities of activities, but it is the same God who works all in all. ⁷ But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to each one for the profit *of all*: ⁸ for to one is given the word of wisdom through the Spirit, to another the word of knowledge through the same Spirit, ⁹ to another faith by the same Spirit, to another gifts of healings by the same Spirit, ¹⁰ to another the working of miracles, to another prophecy, to another discerning of spirits, to another *different* kinds of tongues, to another the interpretation of tongues. ¹¹ But one and the same Spirit works all these things, distributing to each one individually as He wills.

3 Categories/ Groups of Spiritual Gifts

Group 1 Revelation Gifts

Supernaturally *Reveal* Something

1. A WORD OF WISDOM
2. A WORD OF KNOWLEDGE
3. DISCERNING OF SPIRITS

Group 2 Power Gifts

Supernaturally *Do* Something

1. THE GIFT OF SPECIAL FAITH
2. THE GIFTS OF HEALINGS
3. THE WORKINGS OF MIRACLES

Group 3 Vocal/Inspirational Gifts

Supernaturally *Say* Something

1. THE GIFT OF PROPHECY
2. THE GIFT OF TONGUES
3. THE INTERPRETATION OF TONGUES

The Gift of working of miracles is not more miraculous than the other 8 gifts.

Everywhere the Gospel went in the New Testament church, you saw the miracle power of God at work.



A supernatural occurrence is called a miracle because it is beyond our natural comprehension.

Our meaning for the word “MIRACLE” comes from the Latin word: Miraculum

Meaning: to wonder or marvel at

Everything Jesus did and everything the
gifts enable us to do, always reflects
God's wisdom.
Always Brings glory to God.

Greek Words for “Working of Miracles”

Energema = effect operation; thing wrought

Dunamis= Power

Acts 1:8 And you shall receive “DUNAMIS”, after the Holy Spirit has come upon you.

Acts 8:6-7, 13

And the multitudes with one accord heeded the things spoken by Philip, hearing and seeing the miracles which he did. ⁷ For unclean spirits, crying with a loud voice, came out of many who were possessed; and many who were paralyzed and lame were healed.

¹³ Then Simon himself also believed; and when he was baptized he continued with Philip, and was amazed, seeing the miracles and signs which were done.

The gift of faith, God is working on our behalf, but independent of us.

Gift of the working of miracles God is entrusting us with a strength, with a power, that we do not normally have.

Causing us to do or be something that is not natural to our behavior.

Working of miracles =
intervention by God in the course
of nature.

John 14:12 ...he who believes in Me, the works that I do he will do also; and greater *works* than these he will do, because I go to My Father.

Acts 1:8

But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.”



Salvation is God's
Greatest Work.

1 Corinthians 2:4-5

And my speech and my preaching *were* not with persuasive words of human wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power, ⁵ that your faith should not be in the wisdom of men but in the power of God.
