JOHN 14:1-11 KJV

Let not your heart be troubled: ye believe in God, believe also in me.

2 In my Father's house are many mansions: if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you.

3 And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto myself; that where I am, there ye may be also.

4 And whither I go ye know, and the way ye know.

5 Thomas saith unto him, Lord, we know not whither thou goest; and how can we know the way?

6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.

7 If ye had known me, ye should have known my Father also: and from henceforth ye know him, and have seen him.

8 Philip saith unto him, Lord, show us the Father, and it sufficeth us. **9** Jesus saith unto him, Have I been so long time with you, and yet hast thou not known me, Philip? he that hath seen me hath seen the Father; and how sayest thou then, Show us the Father?

10 Believest thou not that I am in the Father, and the Father in me? the words that I speak unto you I speak not of myself: but the Father that dwelleth in me, he doeth the works.

11 Believe me that I am in the Father, and the Father in me: or else believe me for the very works' sake.

1-4 "Do not be troubled. Trust in God and trust in Me. I am going to prepare a place for you and believe Me there is plenty of room in the Father's house. As soon as all is ready, I will come for you and we will be together forever. You already know the way to where I am going."

5-6 Thomas said, "No we do not Lord. We have no idea where you are going, so how could we know the way?" Jesus said, "I am the pathway, the truth and the life, and no one will see the Father except those who receive Me!"

7-8 "If you really knew Me, you would know who the Father is. From this time forward, you know Him because you have seen Him!" Philip said, "Show us the Father and we will be satisfied!"

9-11 Jesus replied, "Philip, I have been with you all this time and you still do not know who I am? Those who have seen Me have seen the Father, so why do you ask to see Him? Don't you believe that the Father and I are one? What I say is what He wants said and then He does His work through Me. Just believe that the Father and I are one or at least believe because of the work you have seen Me do."

ISAIAH 53:4-5 KJV

Surely he hath borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows: yet we did esteem him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted.

5 But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed.

4 Indeed Jesus took away our sickness and disease, bore our physical and mental pain and sorrow yet we simply blamed God as if Jesus deserved the punishment! 5 But the truth is He was defiled and profaned for our transgressions and rebellion, He was crushed for our wrongdoing and guilt. The discipline and correction that would have stolen our peace was assigned to Him, and by His wounds and bruises we are healed and healthy!

MATTHEW 8:14-17 KJV

- **14** And when Jesus was come into Peter's house, he saw his wife's mother laid, and sick of a fever.
- **15** And he touched her hand, and the fever left her: and she arose, and ministered unto them.
- 16 When the even was come, they brought unto him many that were possessed with devils: and he cast out the spirits with his word, and healed all that were sick:
 - **17** That it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Esaias the prophet, saying, Himself took our infirmities, and bare our sicknesses.
