Mark 11:1-11 (N/V)

¹As they approached Jerusalem and came to Bethphage and Bethany at the Mount of Olives, <u>Jesus sent two of his disciples</u>, ²saying to them, "Go to the village ahead of you, and just as you enter it, you will find a colt tied there, which no one has ever ridden. Untie it and bring it here. ³If anyone asks you, 'Why are you doing this?' say, 'The Lord needs it and will send it back here shortly.' "⁴They went and found a colt outside in the street, tied at a doorway. As they untied it, ⁵some people standing there asked, "What are you doing, untying that colt?" ⁶They answered as Jesus had told them to, and <u>the people let them go</u>. ⁷When <u>they brought the colt to Jesus and threw their cloaks over it, he sat on it. ⁸Many people spread their cloaks on the road, while <u>others spread branches they had cut in the fields.</u> ⁹Those who went ahead and those who followed shouted, "Hosanna!" "Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord!" ¹⁰"Blessed is the coming kingdom of our father David!" "Hosanna in the highest heaven!" ¹¹Jesus entered Jerusalem and went into the temple courts. He looked around at everything, but since it was already late, he went out to Bethany with the Twelve.</u>

- King Jesus came to bring peace with God, He came to serve; He came to purchase our freedom; He came to save! (vs. 7; Zecharia 9:9-10; Luke 19:41-44)
