Mark 13:24-37 (N/V)

²⁴"But in those days, following that distress, "'the sun will be darkened, and the moon will not give its light; ²⁵the stars will fall from the sky, and the heavenly bodies will be shaken.' ²⁶"At that time people will see the Son of Man coming in clouds with great power and glory. ²⁷And he will send his angels and gather his elect from the four winds, from the ends of the earth to the ends of the heavens. ²⁸"Now learn this lesson from the fig tree: As soon as its twigs get tender and its leaves come out, you know that summer is near. ²⁹Even so, when you see these things happening, you know that it is near, right at the door. ³⁰Truly I tell you, this generation will certainly not pass away until all these things have happened. ³¹Heaven and earth will pass away, but my words will never pass away.

³²"But <u>about that day or hour no one knows</u>, not even the angels in heaven, nor the Son, but only the Father. ³³Be on guard! Be alert! You do not know when that time will come. ³⁴It's like a man going away: He leaves his house and puts his servants in charge, each with their assigned task, and tells the one at the door to keep watch. ³⁵"Therefore <u>keep watch because you do not know when the owner of the house will come back</u>—whether in the evening, or at midnight, or when the rooster crows, or at dawn. ³⁶If he comes suddenly, do not let him find you sleeping. ³⁷What I say to you, I say to everyone: <u>'Watch!'</u>"

· Jesus came once and He's coming again! (vs. 26-27; John 14:3; Acts 6:1-11)

Why hasn't He come back yet?

"Jesus is delaying His coming because He loves you! He is patiently waiting for the lost to be found, the dead to be made alive, and the captives to be freed."

· Many will be surprised and will be caught off guard by His coming. (vs. 32; Matthew 24:43-44; Revelation 16:15)

Don't question God's timing... His timing is always perfect and purposeful.

· You should live as a wise person. Anchor your life to Jesus' words and live as if you could meet Him face-to-face today. (vs. 31-36; Matthew 7:24-25)
