

HELP IS ON THE WAY

Isaiah 40:27-31 (NASB 1995)

Isaiah 40:27-28

Why do you say, O Jacob, and assert, O Israel, “My way is hidden from the Lord, And the justice due me escapes the notice of my God”? ²⁸ Do you not know? Have you not heard? **The Everlasting God, the Lord, the Creator** of the ends of the earth Does **not** become weary or tired. His understanding is inscrutable.

When the storms of life come our way, do we question God’s sovereignty?

Do we question the greatness of God?

Isaiah 40:29-31

He gives **strength** to the weary, and to *him who* lacks might He increases power.

³⁰ Though youths grow weary and tired, And vigorous young men stumble badly,

³¹ **Yet** those who **wait** for the Lord Will gain **new strength**; They **will** mount up *with* wings like eagles, they will run and not get tired, they will walk and **not** become weary.

How does the eagle metaphor symbolize God’s power? 2 Corinthians 12:9, Philippians 4:13, Acts 1:8

Do the three degrees of power (fly, run, walk) remind us of 1 John 2:12-14? (Three stages of spiritual growth)

Wherever we are God **will** furnish us with **His Grace**!

Grace: “God’s provision for our every need when we need it.” -- John MacArthur
