

FROM THE PASTOR'S PERSPECTIVE...

Last week was a special time for JoAnn and me as we welcomed our new granddaughter, Ava Grace Elizabeth Gaskins, to the world. God has entrusted our son Jeffrey and his wife Bronwyn with a precious little girl who has already brought joy to our hearts!

As we continue to move rapidly through the Lenten season, we're approaching a most special time of the Christian Year, Holy Week. During Holy Week, we remember and reflect on that last week of our Lord's earthly life, focusing on his suffering and death on the cross, then celebrating his glorious resurrection on Sunday morning! We'll have numerous opportunities for reflection and celebration that week.

We'll begin with our Palm Sunday celebration in our regular worship service on April 13. Chowan University will be having a Holy Week campus revival that week in the chapel, and I'll be preaching for the Sunday evening service on Palm Sunday.

On Wednesday, April 16, we will host the final Lenten Lunch for this year at noon. Then at 5:30 that evening, we'll have an Easter Egg Hunt and pizza supper for the children.

Then on Thursday, April 17, we'll have a Maundy Thursday Communion Service at 7:00 p.m. in the sanctuary. At the end of this service, we will move to the fellowship hall to move through the Stations of the Cross that our youth group and leaders will have prepared for the congregation.

Then on Easter Sunday morning, we will celebrate Christ's resurrection in our regular worship service!

Now for us as Christians, Easter Sunday is our highest and holiest day! The reason is obvious: it's when we celebrate the resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ. Without his resurrection, his life and death would have been in vain. We'd still be in sin and without hope (1 Corinthians 15:13-20). In his death and resurrection, Jesus conquered Satan, sin, and death. It's not only joy but



victory that we celebrate when we proclaim: "Christ is risen; he is risen indeed!"

What happened that Sunday morning nearly 2,000 years ago changed everything! It ushered in the beginning of the age to come. Because Jesus was raised, we have assurance that at the last day, we also will be raised. Then our redemption will be brought to perfect completion as even our mortal bodies are redeemed, and we are given a body suited for eternity in the new heavens and new earth. Because Christ conquered death and Hades and now holds their keys (Revelation 1:18), we have the confident hope that death is not the end for us. Not only do we look forward to being with the Lord in heaven; we also look forward to the resurrection and the new creation! The further I go in life and ministry, the more precious this blessed hope becomes to me.

In the history of the church, Easter Sunday has been the *beginning* of the Easter season, which runs for seven weeks until Pentecost (when we celebrate the outpouring of the Holy Spirit on the church, Acts 2). Accordingly, we'll be thinking together in these weeks of Eastertide about the significance of Jesus' resurrection and what it means for us as his church.

Make plans to join us for all these special worship opportunities, and for worship each week here at MBC!
