

FROM THE PASTOR'S PERSPECTIVE

April was a wonderful month in the life of our church! The Lenten Lunches, our worship on the Sundays in Lent, our Holy Week services, our Easter celebration, baptizing a new believer, welcoming another new member – what a wonderful month!

Over the past several months, we have seen some signs of the beginnings of spiritual renewal. We've seen new and returning faces among us, attendance at worship has grown, giving has been generous, and members have been showing signs of spiritual growth. For all these things, thanks and glory be to God!

While May's schedule is not as full, I want to call one particular event to your attention and encourage you to make it a priority. For the past several years, sometime during the spring we have had what we have called a "oneday revival." Last year we were blessed to have Dr. Roger Gilbert, a retired pastor and excellent preacher from Mount Airy as our guest preacher. If you missed that day, you missed a real blessing.

This year we are changing what we call this event. Rather than a "one-day revival," we are calling it our "Spiritual Renewal Focus." It will take place on Sunday morning and evening, May 18. We will also have a fellowship dinner that evening prior to the service.

Our guest preacher will be Dr. Mike Cogdill, a long-time pastor, interim pastor, religion professor, and the founding and long-time Dean of the Campbell University Divinity School. I have known Dr. Cogdill since the early 1980s when I was an undergraduate student at Campbell, where he was teaching religion and sociology. He left Campbell about the time I finished my studies there to return to the pastorate for several years, serving the Spilman Memorial Baptist Church in Kinston. He later returned to Campbell as chair of the Department of Religion and Philosophy and became the founding Dean of the Divinity School when it was established. Fourteen years later he stepped down as Dean but continued teaching in the Divinity School until his retirement in 2019. Throughout his 36 years at Campbell and after his retirement, he has served more than 25



churches as interim or transitional pastor. He has been an outstanding preacher, teacher, and leader, and we are very blessed to have him as our guest preacher for this year's Spiritual Renewal Focus!

The schedule for that day will be as follows:

- Sunday School at 10:00 a.m.
- Morning Worship Service at 11:00 a.m.
- Dinner and Fellowship at 5:00 p.m.
- Evening Worship Service at 7:00 p.m.

I hope you will make this event a priority on your calendar. I want to encourage you to invite inactive church members or unchurched family, friends, and neighbors to attend as well. I look forward to having a good attendance and participation for this focus on spiritual renewal!

May will also bring us two other important days – Mother's Day on May 11 and Memorial Day on May 26. To all our mothers, Happy Mother's Day! And for those who have sacrificed their lives in service to our country to preserve our freedoms, we give thanks.
