# FROM THE PASTOR'S PERSPECTIVE...

Thanksgiving is past, Advent is here, and Christmas will soon be here, too!

As I've said to you before, Advent is not simply celebrating Christmas early. It's a season of penitence and preparation, of anticipation and expectation, as we prepare our hearts to celebrate the birth of our Lord Jesus, the Messiah. It's a time of waiting – just as God's people of ancient times waited for him to fulfill the promise of a Messiah that he had given through the prophets, so we wait and prepare to celebrate Christ's coming as a newborn baby in Bethlehem. And so we wait for our incarnate, crucified, risen, and exalted Messiah and Lord to return in glory! We wait in hope for the fulfillment of his promises of resurrection, judgment, and the new creation. We wait for the coming of the King of kings and Lord of lords to bring in all its fullness his eternal kingdom that has already broken into time!

Now waiting is hard work. We usually want to be *doing something*, in this case, something that will hasten the coming of his kingdom in its fullness. But that is all according to God's time and purpose. In the meantime, we're called to *wait* with faithful, persevering, patient hearts.

And as we look ahead, we prepare our hearts so that we may be ready when he comes.

During this time of year, our culture bombards us with its secular, commercial celebration of the holidays, making it easy to lose sight of what Christmas is really all about. Advent helps us focus and stay focused, reminding us that these are *holy days*. It puts Bethlehem in the context of God's great eternal purpose of redemption, reminding us how God made promises and prepared the way, and that the baby in the manger was God the Son in the flesh, who is King of Kings and Lord of Lords, who will come again to bring his kingdom in its fullness!

So as we move through this season of Advent to Christmas and the celebration of Christ's birth, don't get lost in the hustle and bustle. Stay focused on what we truly celebrate by taking time to worship, and by allowing that worship to direct your celebration.

We'll celebrate Christ's birth together with two special worship opportunities. The choir from Middle Swamp Baptist Church will join our choir on Sunday, December 14 at 3:00 p.m. to present the Christmas cantata, "Peace Has Come." Then on Christmas Eve at 5:30 p.m., we'll gather in the

sanctuary for our Christmas Eve Candlelight Service of Lessons, Carols, and Communion. This is always a special time of worship, and I encourage you to make it a priority as we remember together how "the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld his glory, glory as of the only begotten from the Father, full of grace and truth" (John 1:14).

On a different note, I want to commend our congregation for all the local mission efforts we participate in throughout the year and during the holiday season: the Food Bank and our food pantry distributions, benevolence ministries, the Souper Bowl of Caring, Backpack Buddies, community involvement, the Angel Tree, the White Christmas food boxes, and much more. Of all the churches I have served as Pastor, I don't think any have done as much to serve their surrounding community as Murfreesboro Baptist Church does. My prayer is that God will use these demonstrations of love, care, and concern to open people's hearts to hear the message of the gospel as we have opportunities to share it with them.
