

He Promises—2 Hearing God’s Voice

“The one who enters by the gate is the shepherd of the sheep. ³... and the sheep listen to his voice. He calls his own sheep by name and leads them out. ⁴... and his sheep follow him because they know his voice.”
John 10:2-4 NIV

How to Hear God’s Voice

1. Ask God to speak to you.

... Then Eli realized that the LORD was calling the boy. ⁹So Eli told Samuel, “Go and lie down, and if he calls you, say, ‘Speak, LORD, for your servant is listening.’” ... 1 Samuel 3:8-9

2. Listen to what He says.

“Call to me and I will answer you ...” Jeremiah 33:3 NIV

Whether you turn to the right or to the left, your ears will hear a voice behind you, saying, “This is the way; walk in it.” Isaiah 30:21 NIV

3. Do what He tells you to do.

[Jesus] replied, “Blessed rather are those who hear the word of God and obey it.” Luke 11:28 NIV

... “Be still, and know that I am God ...” Psalm 46:10 NIV

... And after the fire came a gentle whisper. 1 Kings 19:12 NIV

“Here I am! I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears my voice and opens the door, I will come in and eat with that person, and they with me.” Revelation 3:20 NIV
