- They were very poor, yet irrationally generous.
- They were enduring trials, yet overflowing with joy.

2 Money Mindsets

1. The Bag Mindset: We don't have enough.

"... You eat, <u>but do not have enough</u>; you drink, but you are not filled with drink; you clothe yourselves, but no one is warm; and he who earns wages, earns wages to put into a bag with holes."

Haggai 1:6 NKJV

2. The Barn Mindset: We have more than enough.

The LORD will send a blessing on your <u>barns</u> and on <u>everything you put your hand to</u>. The LORD your God will bless you in the land he is giving you. Deuteronomy 28:8 NIV





Honor the LORD with your wealth, with the firstfruits of all your crops; ¹⁰then your barns will be filled to overflowing, and your vats will brim over with new wine. Proverbs 3:9-10 NIV
