# **3 Truths About Temptation**

## 1. It's not a sin to be tempted.

Jesus understands every weakness of ours, because <u>he was tempted in every way that we are</u>. <u>But he did not sin!</u> Hebrews 4:15 CEV

## God may test you, but He'll never tempt you.

And remember, when you are being tempted, <u>do not say</u>, "<u>God is tempting me</u>." God ... never tempts anyone else. <sup>14</sup>Temptation comes from our own desires, which entice us and drag us away. <sup>15</sup>These desires give birth to sinful actions. And when sin is allowed to grow, it gives birth to death. James 1:13-15 NLT

#### 2. You're most vulnerable to temptation when you're weak, and when you think you're strong.

So, if you think you are standing firm, be careful that you don't fall!

1 Corinthians 10:12 NIV

Stay alert! Watch out for your great enemy, the devil. He prowls around like a roaring lion, looking for someone to devour.

1 Peter 5:8 NLT

#### Temptation often comes through a door that's been deliberately left open.

### One of the best ways to resist temptation is to eliminate it.

Do not set foot on the path of the wicked or walk in the way of evildoers. <sup>15</sup>Avoid it, do not travel on it; turn from it and go on your way. Proverbs 4:14-15 NIV

## 3. God will always give you a way out.

... And God is faithful; he will not let you be tempted beyond what you can bear. But when you are tempted, he will also provide a way out so that you can endure it. 1 Corinthians 10:13 NIV

- ... "People do not live by bread alone, but by every word that comes from the mouth of God." Matthew 4:4 NLT
- ... "Do not put the Lord your God to the test." Matthew 4:7 NIV

Godly sorrow brings repentance that leads to salvation and leaves no regret, but worldly sorrow brings death. 2 Corinthians 7:10 NIV
