BIBLE STORY

I LOVE MY FAITH

Supplies: Box or Basket, Bean bag, masking tape

Instructions: Use the masking tape to create a line on the floor about five feet from the box or basket. Set the beanbags just behind the line.

Have your child/children take turns throwing the beanbag into the box. Before the child throws the beanbag, he'll say, "My name is (fill in child's name) and I love to (fill in favorite thing to do at church)," or "my favorite color is (fill in with favorite color)," or "my favorite toy is (fill in with favorite toy)." Get creative and think of different things to say before taking turns throwing the beanbag. Parents fill free to join in the fun.

ANGEL'S WINGS

Instructions: Play a game similar to Follow the Leader, reminding children of the angel God sent to Mary in today's part of The Big God Story.

Relate: In The Big God Story, God sent someone to tell Zechariah and Mary some very important news: An angel of the Lord.

Ask your child, "Do you think an angel flies fast or slow?" We're going to pretend we're angels who can fly fast and slow, high and low. Let's all practice flapping our wings. Flap wings along with children. Explain that you'll give them directions on how to fly. You can ask them to go fast, slow, on their tiptoes, on their knees, hopping, walking backward, etc.

BLESSING

A blessing is a prayer of commission, a portion of scripture, or words of encouragement and guidance. This can be done to close the lesson, or done before bed. While giving the blessing, you may desire to lay hands on your child as you speak the Scripture or pray a prayer over them.

Pray: (Child's name), may you always know that God loves you so much that He gave The Promise—Jesus—to you. (Child's name), may you remember Jesus is The Promise and share Him with others. We love you and praise you Lord. Amen.
