ACTIVITY #1

Supplies: music and a piece of tissue for each person in the family participating

Instructions: I'm going to play some music, and as the music plays, members of the family will slowly and carefully walk in a big circle. When I stop the music, you must freeze and turn to the person on your right to answer the question I'll ask. I'll give you a minute to answer the question with each other, and then I'll start the music again. The next time the music stops, you'll freeze and turn to the person on your left to answer the question. The tricky part of this game is that you must keep the tissue on your head as you travel in the circle. If the tissue falls off, you can't pick it up yourself; you must wait for a friend to pick it up and place it back on your head for you.

Questions:

- What was the first thing you did this morning after you woke up?
- What's your favorite thing to eat for breakfast?
- What's your favorite part about Easter?
- Do you have a favorite toy to play with?
- What is your favorite movie?
- Who is your favorite person from the Bible?
- What's your favorite thing to play on at the playground?
- Would you rather blow bubbles or draw with sidewalk chalk?
- Would you rather have cake or ice cream?
- What's your favorite flavor of ice cream?

JESUS LOVES ME!

Supplies: Paper, paint, stickers, crayons, markers

Instructions:

Jesus died on the cross for you and me because He loves us so much! Help your child write on their paper Jesus loves (Insert Child's Name). Encourage your child to paint, draw, apply stickers to their art. Help your child hang up their artwork as a reminder that Jesus loves us, died on the cross for our sins and is alive today in our hearts!

BLESSING

A blessing is a prayer of commission, a portion of scripture, or words of encouragement and guidance. This can be done to close the lesson, or done before bed. While giving the blessing, you may desire to lay hands on your child as you speak the Scripture or pray a prayer over them.

Pray: (Child's name), may you always remember that Jesus is your Savior and Jesus is alive! May you know that God loves you very much. In Jesus Name I pray, Amen.
