HOW TALL IS YOUR CASTLE?

Supplies: Blocks, Any kind of boxes you can find in your home and kitchen (ex. Cereal boxes, Cracker boxes, Cardboard boxes, Oatmeal canisters); sheets, pillows, etc.

Instructions:

In today's part of The Big God Story, Esther, a young Jewish woman, is chosen to live in the palace as King Darius's new queen. We're all royal kings and queens this morning. But we don't have a castle to live in; we need to build our own! Look around your house to find objects to build a castle like blocks, pillows, boxes, or sheets! You can build them however you'd like.

Set up stuff to make a castle or fort in one corner of a room. As your child builds, ask them questions about their castles. How tall is your castle going to be? What color is your castle? Are there any animals that live at your castle? Do you have a swimming pool? What does it look like? How many people live in your castle?

WHERE IS ESTHER'S CROWN?

Supplies: Yellow Paper, Scissors

Instructions:

- Use the yellow paper and scissors to help your child make their own crown!
- Then take turns hiding the crown around your house and take turns finding it!

BLESSING

A blessing is a prayer of commission, a portion of scripture, or words of encouragement and guidance. This can be done to close the lesson, or done before bed. While giving the blessing, you may desire to lay hands on your child as you speak the Scripture or pray a prayer over them.

Pray: (Child's name), may you remember that God is the one true and living God. May you know that God loves you very much. May you remember that God has the power to save you. In Jesus Name I pray, Amen.
