BIBLE STORY

POP THEM

Supplies: Bubbles

Instructions: Explain to children that you'll ask them some questions before you blow the bubbles. They can only pop the bubbles if the answer applies to them.

Possible questions:

- Who's wearing (fill in color)?
- Who has a brother?
- Who has a sister?
- Who likes pizza?
- Who likes to swing on swings at the park?
- Who likes to play soccer?
- Who likes to brush your teeth?
- Who likes to ride your bike?
- Who likes to go swimming?
- Who likes to draw?

WE ARE IN GOD'S FAMILY

Supplies: White Paper, Markers, Finger Paints, Disposable plates (small)

Relate: Mary and Joseph were going to have a brand-new family. When we choose to trust and obey Jesus, we become a part of God's family. In this activity, the children will create a painting to express praise and worship for God's Promise, Jesus.

Set Up: Help your child write on the white paper in large block letters the words "God's Family." Put paints on the small plates and set the plates around the table.

Instructions: Encourage your child to paint God's family.

BLESSING

A blessing is a prayer of commission, a portion of scripture, or words of encouragement and guidance. This can be done to close the lesson, or done before bed. While giving the blessing, you may desire to lay hands on your child as you speak the Scripture or pray a prayer over them.

Pray:

"(Child's name), we're a part of God's family." May you know Jesus is The Promise and God's gift to you! Thank you for sending Your Son Jesus to save us. We love you! Amen.
