## BIBLE STORY

### **LION OR PRAY**

Supplies: Lion Card; Praying Card

#### **Instructions:**

We learned that God is the living God who kept the mouths of the lions shut. Now we're going to play a game where we'll pretend to be lions! We're going to crawl across this open space pretending to be lions. When I hold up the lion card, you can crawl and roar, but when I hold up the praying hands card, you'll stop and fold your hands as if you're Daniel praying to God. If you keep moving when the praying hands are up, you'll have to move backward five crawls. Whoever crosses the finish line first wins. Let's play!

Hold up the lion and praying hands cards one at a time, quickly changing them until a child crosses the finish line

# **MEMORY VERSE**

**Supplies:** Yellow Card Stock, brown paint, two googley eyes, markers

#### Instructions:

- As they ponder the truth that God is the living God, have your child paint a lion with it's mane and share about areas where they need God's help. After your child finishes drawing the lions face and painting it's mane, help your child glue the two googley eyes on their paper.
- Help your child write on the bottom of the page Daniel 6:23: Daniel was brought out, unharmed...because he had trusted in his God.

## **BLESSING**

A blessing is a prayer of commission, a portion of scripture, or words of encouragement and guidance. This can be done to close the lesson, or done before bed. While giving the blessing, you may desire to lay hands on your child as you speak the Scripture or pray a prayer over them.

**Pray:** (Child's name), may you remember that God is the one true and living God. May you know that God loves you very much. May you remember that God is living and ready to help you. In Jesus Name I pray, Amen.
