## **GOOD NEWS SHOUT!**

**Supplies:** Two paper plates, about 10-20 beans, paint stick and tape, markers, crayons.

#### Steps:

- 1. Have your child decorate their paper plates however they would like.
- 2. Tape a paint stick to the inside of a paper plate. Put beans on the plate. Tape another plate on top.
- 3. Ask your child why do people cheer? We cheer when we hear good news. Allow children to share about good things happening in their lives.

**Relate:** Today we are going to cheer for Jesus! Demonstrate for children a cheer using big motions and lots of movement. (For example: Hip Hip Hooray! I am saved by Jesus! Or I got to play with my friends today!) Encourage your child to use their rattle to create a cheer and a good news dance!

## **MEMORY VERSE**

Praise: Hold hands up in the air and wiggle all fingers.

**be to the Lord:** Use right hand to make an L with index finger and thumb at left shoulder. Cross over front of body and end on right hip.

**the God of Israel:** Extend right hand in front of body with palm facing to side. Bring hand to rest fingertips just below chin.

**because he has come to his people:** Hold out both arms at sides of body and pull inward to hug chest.

and redeemed them: Place palms together in prayer motion.

### **BLESSING**

A blessing is a prayer of commission, a portion of scripture, or words of encouragement and guidance. This can be done to close the lesson, or done before bed. While giving the blessing, you may desire to lay hands on your child as you speak the Scripture or pray a prayer over them.

**Pray:** (Child's name), God always keeps His promises. God is worthy of our praise! He shows us His Promise Jesus! (Child's name), may you share the good news of Jesus with someone this week. May you know God has shown you and given you The Promise, Jesus. In Jesus Name I pray, Amen.
