Thesis Verse: 1:3-7 - “We are bound to thank God always for you, brethren, as it is fitting, because your faith grows exceedingly, and the love of every one of you all abounds toward each other, ⁴so that we ourselves boast of you among the churches of God for your patience and faith in all your persecutions and tribulations that you endure, ⁵which is manifest evidence of the righteous judgment of God, that you may be counted worthy of the kingdom of God, for which you also suffer; ⁶since it is a righteous thing with God to repay with tribulation those who trouble you, ⁷and to give you who are troubled rest with us when the Lord Jesus is revealed from heaven with His mighty angels,”

Thesis Statement: “Continue steadfast in your faith, endure trials, and always be ready for in due time the Righteous Judgment of Jesus will come. The faithful will persevere and find rest but the unfaithful, along with Satan and his dominion, will be punished with everlasting destruction and condemnation.”

Chapter Themes

1. Ch 1 vs 5 - Endurance of the Saint unto the Righteous Judgment of Jesus.
 - a. 3-4 - Thankfulness for their testimony of endurance to others.
 - b. 5-7 - The Righteousness of the judgment of Jesus on all
 - c. 8-12 - Necessity of enduring for the Gospel to the lost
2. Ch 2 vs 3 - Avoiding **Apostasy through thankfulness for the calling of Jesus to believe the Gospel
 - a. 1-12 - Revelation of the Lawless One that leads to apostasy in the deceived
 - b. 13-17 - Endurance of the Saint because of the revelation of Jesus and God’s calling to salvation
3. Ch 3 vs 1-2 - Prayer for endurance and admonishment
 - a. 1-5 - Pray for one another to endure in their faith
 - b. 6-10 - Act like a believer
 - c. 11-15 - Admonish the brother who doesn’t walk according to the Gospel (15)
 - d. 16-18 - Peace be given

3. Help others when they stumble or become lazy / apathetic
