

Opening Discussion / Icebreaker:

What's something you know how to do really well now that you once needed help learning?
Who helped you along the way?

(Connects naturally to the "I was blind, now I see" illustration.)

Life Group Questions

Purpose – Witness

In Acts 1:1–3, Luke describes this book as continuing what Jesus “began to do and teach.”
What does that tell us about how Jesus is still working in the world today—and what role the church plays in that?

Ordinary People, Simple Testimony

The sermon emphasized that being a witness doesn't require expertise—just a story.
What parts of your own story with Jesus feel simple, honest, and shareable right now? What makes that hard sometimes?

Power – Waiting on the Spirit

Jesus told the disciples to wait before going out on mission (Acts 1:4–8).
Why do you think waiting was necessary, and what does “waiting on the Spirit” look like in everyday life today?

Dependence vs. Self-Reliance

We heard about the danger of doing life and ministry in our own strength instead of the Spirit's power.
Where are you most tempted to rely on yourself rather than depend on God? What might surrender look like in that area?

Prayer – United and Persistent

Acts 1:14 shows the church united and continually praying together.
What keeps prayer central—or pushes it to the margins—in your life and in our church community? How could we grow in prayer together?
