

Life Group Questions — Acts 2

Big Idea: When the Spirit fills the church, the church becomes impossible to ignore.

Ice Breaker- What's a sound that immediately gets your attention—no matter where you are? (Sirens, alarms, a baby crying, your phone buzzing, etc.)

Have someone read Acts 2:1–4 out loud.

The believers were together and waiting when the Spirit came. Why do you think unity and prayer mattered before the power showed up?

The crowd had two reactions: “What does this mean?” and “They’re drunk.” Why do you think people still respond to the work of God in those same two ways today?

Read Acts 2:37–38 together.

The crowd moves from curiosity to conviction. What's the difference between being interested in Jesus and being pierced to the heart?

Why do you think repentance is often seen as negative when Scripture presents it as a gift?

Read Acts 2:42 together.

Which of the four devotions stands out most to you right now? Which one do you need to work on most?

Prayer

Close by praying Acts 2:42–47 over your group—that God would make you united, devoted, prayerful, and Spirit-led, and that He would add to your number as He sees fit.
