Philippians 2:1-4 (NLT)

- 1 Is there any encouragement from belonging to Christ? Any comfort from his love? Any fellowship together in the Spirit? Are your hearts tender and compassionate?
- 2 Then make me truly happy by agreeing wholeheartedly with each other, loving one another, and working together with one mind and purpose.
- 3 Don't be selfish; don't try to impress others. Be humble, thinking of others as better than yourselves.
- 4 Don't look out only for your own interests, but take an interest in others, too.

Verse 2 points out the key - "working together with one mind and purpose" - **ONE**

Why work as one, why work as a team?

 We're <u>FAMILY</u> *Ephesians 2:19 (NLT)* So now you Gentiles are no longer strangers and foreigners. You are citizens along with all of God's holy people. You are members of God's family.

• We need <u>EACH OTHER</u>

Romans 12:6 (NLT)

In his grace, God has given us different gifts for doing certain things well...

• We get more **DONE**

Ecclesiastes 4:9 (NLT)

Two people are better off than one, for they can help each other succeed.

What does it take to make a successful TEAM (at FCC)?

T - Team members must have <u>TRUST</u>
 1 Timothy 6:20 (NLT)
 Timothy, guard what God has entrusted to you...

Here are three ways you can gain and maintain trust:

- Be CONSISTENT Luke 16:10 NIV
- Be CONFIDENTIAL Proverbs 11:13 NIV
- Be CLOSE Proverbs 17:17 MSG
 - E Team members must have <u>EMPATHY</u>

 1 Peter 3:8 (NLT)

Finally, all of you should be of one mind. Sympathize with each other. Love each other as brothers and sisters. Be tenderhearted, and keep a humble attitude.

Here are some tools that will help you empathize:

- Slow DOWN James 1:19
- Ask **QUESTIONS** *Proverbs 20:5*
- Show **EMOTIONS** Romans 12:15
 - A Team members must <u>ACCOMMODATE</u>
 - 2 Timothy 2:22 (CEV)
 - ...Be faithful, loving, and easy to get along with...

Here are some ways to accommodate each other:

- Accommodate each other's NEEDS Romans 15:2 MSG
- Accommodate each other's IDEAS Proverbs 18:15 TLB
- Accommodate each other's PERSONALITIES Romans 12:6 GW
- Accommodate each other's FAULTS Ephesians 4:2 TLB
 - M Team members must stay on <u>MISSION</u> *Philippians 2:2 (NLT)*

Then make me truly happy by agreeing wholeheartedly with each other, loving one another, and working together with one mind and purpose.

Look at the actions words in Philippians 2:2...

- Agreeing
- Loving
- Working Together
