- Your future can be **<u>GREATER</u>** than your past
- God has always made a way for us to escape our past and

deliver us into a greater and much better future

- You <u>CAN'T</u>, and God <u>WON'T</u> change your past
- You <u>CAN</u>, and God <u>WILL</u> change your future

Background

Judges 13

- The Lord handed Israel over to the Philistines (v.1)
- Manoah and wife (Hazelelponi) were promised a son (vv.2-3,5)
- Samson's birth was a MIRACLE
- God blessed Samson (v.24)

Samson was a man of faith, but he certainly wasn't a faithful man.

Judges 14

- Samson chose women above **GOD**
- Samson chose women above FAMILY (vv.1-3)
 - Cf. Exodus 34:12-16, Deuteronomy 7:1-3; 1 John 2:16
- Samson was a man of riddles (vv.12-20)
- Samson was a murderer (vv.19) Judges 15 (vv.1-20)

Judges 16

- Samson spent the night with a prostitute (v.1)
- Samson's next love interest was Delilah
- Delilah schemed to turn Samson over to the Philistines (vv.4-22)
- Samson was a Nazarite: 3 "Nots" of a Nazarite (Numbers 6)
 - Not drink wine (vv.3-4)
 - Not cut hair (v.5)
 - Not come into contact with a dead person (vv.6-8)
- Samson's STRENGTH comes from God
- Samson's actions caused God's strength to leave him (vv.20-22)

Samson's Victory

- The Philistines wanted to humiliate Samson (v.25)
- Samson used his strength to kill 3,000 Philistines (vv.28-31)
- You can't look at Samson's life without seeing the
 REASON for his life
- Samson's **PURPOSE** is to begin to rescue Israel from the Philistines that's exactly what he did
- Samson did not let Delilah define him, God **DEFINED** him
