1. Matthew 4:18-20

Peter was a **FISHERMAN**

2. Luke 9:18-27

Jesus poured Himself into Peter and the other disciples for three years.

Luke 9:23 sums up what Jesus expected.

3. Luke 9:28

Peter was a **DISCIPLE** of Jesus

4. Matthew 26:33-35

Jesus prepared the disciples in Matthew 26:31 - then Peter started talking.

Peter essentially argues with Jesus, saying he won't do what Jesus already knows he will do!

5. Matthew 26:69-75

Just as Jesus said, Peter denied knowing Jesus - three times!

6. Luke 22:62

Peter cried like a baby because he understood his sin.

The change in Peter's life became real in a moment of **BROKENESS**.

How this Impacts Us

So often we feel the conviction to follow Jesus. We realize we need a Savior and we may start following Jesus in the moment, but when life gets tough, we run away just like Peter did. Unless we come to a place of brokenness, realizing our life needs to be put back together (by the Master), we will never be completely changed.

Peter wasn't known for his rebellion or cowardly ways, he was known as a committed follower of Jesus. He was known as the man who preached a life changing message one day at Pentecost where 3,000 souls were added to the church! Praise God our past doesn't define our future - our future can be greater than our past!
