Jesus designed the church to bring us together, because we were never designed to do life alone! You were created for COMMUNITY!

- God <u>CHOSE</u> you
- to become like <u>JESUS</u>

Practical Ways We Grow Together (Hand in Hand)

• You grow together when you <u>AFFIRM</u> each other

You can affirm one another:

with <u>ACCEPTANCE</u> (Romans 15:7 NLT | Therefore, accept each other just as Christ has accepted you so that God will be given glory.)
with <u>ATTENTION</u> (Galatians 6:10 NCV | When we have the opportunity to help anyone, we should do it. But we should give special attention to those who are in the family of believers.)

- with <u>AFFECTION</u> (Romans 12:10 NLT | Love each other with genuine affection, and take delight in honoring each other.)

- with <u>APPRECIATION</u> (1 Thessalonians 5:12 NCV | Now, brothers and sisters, we ask you to appreciate those who work hard among you, who lead you in the Lord and teach you.)

- You grow together when you <u>PRAY</u> for each other

 - 2. Ephesians 3:17-19 TLB
 - 3. Hebrews 13:21 CEV
 - 4. Romans 15:13 NCV
 - 5. Ephesians 1:17 GW

- You grow together when you are <u>HONEST</u> with each other

Ephesians 4:25 (NCV)

...Tell each other the truth, because we all belong to each other in the same body.

Four benefits of honesty:

- Emotional <u>HEALING</u> (James 5:16 TLB)
- Fresh <u>START</u> (Proverbs 28:13 TLB)
- Power to <u>CHANGE</u> (James 4:10 NLT)
- Deeper <u>FELLOWSHIP</u> (1 John 1:7 TEV)
 - You grow together when you <u>ENCOURAGE</u> each other

Romans 1:12 (NCV)

I mean that I want us to help each other with the faith we have. Your faith will help me, and my faith will help you.

You were created by God to love, grow, serve, and share. We do that at Fellowship through our six purposes (we believe it's the six purposes of the church):

- 1. Worship passionately
- 2. Evangelize lovingly
- 3. Disciple intentionally
- 4. Minister equally
- 5. Fellowship regularly
