Matthew 22:37-39 (NLT)

Matthew 22:37 comes from Deuteronomy 6:5

Strength Comes From

- Heart and Soul
 - Deuteronomy 4:29
 - Deuteronomy 10:12
 - Joshua 22:5
- Heart, Soul, Mind, and Strength
 - Mark 12:30
 - Luke 10:27

There is a spiritual connection between your mind and your strength!

Jesus' Response to Sin

- Non-Repentant
 - It ticks Jesus off, He gets mad

Examples:

- Jesus calls them fools on the walk to Emmaus (Luke 24:25)
- He called Peter Satan (Matthew 16:23)
- He called the Pharisees hypocrites and blind (Matthew 23)
- He even called them
- Children of hell (Matthew 23:15)
- Whitewashed tombs (Matthew 23:27)
- Brood of vipers (Matthew 23:33)

Rules without relationship is religion!

All these people who thought they were living good and decent lives... even the ones who were justifying and explaining away their sin – they all would come to Jesus in the name of religion and he would shatter them! The words he used left nothing to the imagination – you knew where he stood on their actions, their lifestyle, and their sin!

Matthew 22:29 (NLT)
