It's Not Too Late

- Your future can be **GREATER** than your past
- God has always made a way for us to escape our past and deliver us into a greater and much better future
 - You **CAN'T**, and God **WON'T** change your past
 - You **CAN**, and God **WILL** change your future

Suitcases of Life

- We put our past in suitcases and lug them around with us, leaving us tired and hurt
- Those feelings aren't because of *what's in* the suitcases, carrying them around wears us down
- It's not your past, it's the fact you can't **LET GO** of it

Moses

- The man, the legend
 - Exodus 3 – burning bush experience
 - Exodus 5 to 12 – miracles to open Pharaoh's eyes
 - Exodus 12 – Moses led Hebrews out of Egypt
 - Exodus 14 – Moses parted the Red Sea
 - Exodus 16 – Hebrews were fed with manna and quail
 - Exodus 17 – Hebrews drank water from a rock
 - Exodus 19 to 20 – Moses received Ten Commandments

- God was working through a **MURDERER**
 - Think about the characteristics of a murderer
 - Murder is a *thing* but the problem is the *heart*
 - Moses acted like a guilty man with a guilty conscious
 - Read **Exodus 2:11-15**

What Changed Moses

- Moses had a burning bush **INTERVENTION**
 - Read **Exodus 3:11-15**
 - He was confronted with his sin and a door opened to choose another path, it requires starting over
 - People in Egypt needed to be confronted with the **NEW** Moses
 - Once you have an intervention, you must choose each and every day – which one will I be today – old or new

Moses was a murderer, but he turned his life upside down and he turned his life completely around.

He made mistakes, but his mistakes didn't define him.

His past didn't predict his future!

Without Moses saying, "Here I am"

the Hebrew people might still be slaves to Egypt.

One day Moses had to be told, it ain't over yet!

The choice is yours... it ain't over yet!
