IN PREPARATION

General Douglas MacArthur famously said, "I shall return." after having to evacuate a U.S./Filipino campaign that was being overrun by the Japanese in the Spring of 1942. On October 20, 1944, wading through the water and walking ashore onto the Philippine island Leyte, General MacArthur made good on his promise to liberate the Filipino people from Japanese control when he broadcast to them, "People of the Philippines: I have returned."

Though General MacArthur holds a special place in history for liberating a war torn people and their nation, in a vastly superior way, King Jesus came to liberate His people from the devastation of sin. His mission to liberate us will be fully realized when He fulfills His promise to return for us.


