TALK IT OVER

Start Talking: Find a conversation starter for your group. (15 Min)

• What dangers (big or small) do you pray for help or rescue from?

Head: Start Thinking. Ask a question to get your group thinking. (10 Min)

- Read Matthew 6:9-13 what does the Lord's prayer end with? Who is the Evil one? (Luther's Large Catechism Sixth petition)
- Read Matthew 4:1-11, who is temping Jesus and how does he tempt him? What are some other names for the Evil one that the bible identifies him as. How can we be protected from him?
- Read James 1:12-13, does God tempt us? Why or why not? Heart: Start Sharing. Choose a question to create openness. (10 Min)
- Is Evil and temptation the same thing? Why are why not? Are you sinning when you are being tempted?
- What is the difference between being tempted and being tested? Does God test us?
- How does God deliver us from evil(evil one)? Has evil been destroyed by the power of the cross? If so, why do we still encounter great evils in this world?
- If you could choose one evil to disappear from this world right now what would it be?

Hands: Start Doing. Commit to a step and live it out this week. (10 Min)

- How are your prayer journals going?
- How can you help with the fight against evil?

Start Praying. Be bold and pray with power. (15 Min)
