Warm Ups (15 Min)

- Everyone share a “High” from the week and a “Low” from the week.
- Everyone share a “God moment” from the week.

Scripture Study (30 Min)

- If you were able to attend Sunday Worship, what impacted you the most?
- Are there any similarities between Hosea and Job? Where do those similarities start and where do they stop?
- When you think of ‘grace,’ what’s the first thing that comes to mind?
- There are multiple senses or ways in which the word “Grace” is used. List a few.
- Read Romans 11:1-6. In what sense is the word being used?
- The Greek word for “grace” (χάριτι · chariti) is sometimes translated as God’s *favor*. What’s the connection between the two concepts?
- Have you ever realized that you had a false sense of entitlement about a certain thing?
- **Action Point:** Memorize Ephesians 2:8-10. Write it down and put it in a visible place.
- How are Grace and Gratitude related to each other?
- **Action Point:** Have you ever kept a gratitude journal? This week you might give it a try! Every day list 50 things you’re thankful for. It’s guaranteed to change your perspective!
- **Action Point:** Is there someone in your life that you need to give more grace to? Why do they deserve it?
- **Action Point:** Read Colossians 4:6, Ephesians 4:29. Evaluate your speech in light of these passages. Do you need to make any changes to the language you use?
