Gospel Partners A Pastor's Divine Jealousy 2 Corinthians 11



Parallel Scripture

3 But I, brothers, could not address you as spiritual people, but as people of the flesh, as infants in Christ. ²I fed you with milk, not solid food, for you were not ready for it. And even now you are not yet ready, ³ for you are still of the flesh. For while there is jealousy and strife among you, are you not of the flesh and behaving only in a human way? ⁴ For when one says, "I follow Paul," and another, "I follow Apollos," are you not being merely human?⁵ What then is Apollos? What is Paul? Servants through whom you believed, as the Lord assigned to each. ⁶ I planted, Apollos watered, but God gave the growth. ⁷ So neither he who plants nor he who waters is anything, but only God who gives the growth. 8 He who plants and he who waters are one, and each will receive his wages according to his labor. 9 For we are God's fellow workers. You are God's field, God's building.

1 Corinthians 3:1-9 ESV

Start Talking: Find a conversation starter for your group. (15 Min)

- What is something that you've found yourself being jealous of?
- Is there ever a time where jealousy is appropriate?

Head: Start Thinking. Ask a question to get your group thinking. (10 Min)

- Was there any one thing that you most agreed with or disagreed with from last weekend's message? What was it and why?
- Read 2 Corinthians 11. What is Paul jealous for? Does he have a right to be jealous or not?
- Paul is responding to so-called "super-apostles" who are proclaiming "another Jesus." What is the danger of accepting teachings regarding Jesus without reflection?

Heart: Start Sharing. Choose a question to create openness. (10 Min)

- What are some things you will boast about? What should we boast about?
- Do you feel like Paul is just trying to defending himself or trying to make a bigger point? If so, what is his point?
- Does God ever get jealous? If so, of what?

Hands: Start Doing. Commit to a step and live it out this week. (10 Min)

- When you are tempted to lift yourself up, how can you give that glory to God?
- Pray for our pastors that they will do their best to lead with humble hearts.

Start Praying. Be bold and pray with power. (15 Min)

- 1. What's a passage of scripture that has impacted you this week? Read it to the group and explain why.
- 2. Is there anything God is leading you to repent of?
- 3. How's your weekly 3-2-1 challenge going? (3 Conversations with New People, Learn 2 Names, Make 1 Meaningful Connection)
- 4. Who is one non-believer that you need to reach out to this week?
- 5. What's something you'd like someone else to check in with you about this week?
- 6. Pray for one another.
