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# Start Talking. Find a conversation starter for your group.

- What's the last book you read?
- Do you usually say "Scripture," "God's Word," or "The Bible?"

# Head: Start Thinking. Ask a question to get your group thinking.

- Read Deuteronomy 6:6-9. Then watch this video: https://vimeo.com/54601664#t=700s
- Read Isaiah 55:11 and Romans 10:17. What promises are given to us by God in these passages?

# Heart: Start Sharing. Choose a question to create openness.

- The Holy Spirit creates faith, whether it be through the baptism of an infant (who cannot yet reason), through a life-changing experience (such as Saul of Tarsus experienced), or through the hearing of God's Word. Think of a person who is literally "soaked" with water. What do we look like / act like / sound like when we are "soaked" in the scriptures?
- Read Joshua 1:1-9. There is much emphasis in this passage about obeying God's Word. Obedience is not our favorite word, and it's a motif that probably isn't highlighted in churches as much as the "believe" motif. Do you think obedience needs to be emphasized more, the same, or less?

#### Hands: Start Doing. Commit to a step and live it out this week.
