- How do Paul's own experiences as an evangelist align with his message in this section?
- Read Romans 8:18. What awaits those who suffer for Christ 's Name

# Heart: Start Sharing. Choose a question to create openness. (10 Min)

- Have you ever felt persecuted? If so in what way?
- How has Jesus helped you in times of persecution?
- What is the difference between the persecution of the early church and now? Is it different? What can we learn from the early church?

# Hands: Start Doing. Commit to a step and live it out this week. (10 Min)

- How can we as a church support one another when faced with struggles and persecution?
- How will you love your enemy?

### Start Praying. Be bold and pray with power. (15 Min)
