Titus 3:5 NASB

5 He saved us, not on the basis of deeds which we have done in righteousness, but according to His mercy, by the washing of regeneration and renewing by the Holy Spirit

Sanctification and Love

- 1 Received from us instruction as to how you ought to walk and please God, that you excel still more.
- 2 For this is the will of God, your sanctification; that is, that you abstain from sexual immorality.
- 3 That each of you know how to possess his own vessel in sanctification and honor, not in lustful passion, like the Gentiles who do not know God;
- 4. And that no man transgress and defraud his brother in the matter because the Lord is the avenger in all these things,
- 5. We also told you before and warned you.
- 6. For God has not called us for the purpose of impurity, but in sanctification.
- 7. So, he who rejects this is not rejecting man but the God who gives His Holy Spirit to you.
- 8. Now as to the love of the brethren, you have no need for anyone to write to you, for you yourselves are taught by God to love one another;
- 9. Make it your ambition to lead a quiet life and attend to your own business and work with your hands, just as we commanded you, so that you will behave properly toward outsiders and not be in any need.

1 Peter 2 NASB

- 1. Put aside all malice and all deceit and hypocrisy and envy and all slander, 2 like newborn babies, long for the pure milk of the word, so that by it you may grow in respect to salvation.
- 2. Lord living stone which has been rejected by men, but is choice and precious in the sight of God,
- 3. People stumble because they are disobedient to the word,
- 4. But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for God's own possession, so that you may proclaim the excellencies of Him who has called you out of darkness into His marvelous light;
- 5. Beloved, I urge you to abstain from fleshly lusts which wage war against the soul.
- 6. For what credit is there if, when you sin and are harshly treated, you endure it with patience? But if when you do what is right and suffer for it you patiently endure it, this finds favor with God.
- 7. Christ Is Our Example 21 For you have been called for this purpose, since Christ also suffered for you, leaving you an example for you to follow in His steps, 22 who committed no sin, nor was any deceit found in His mouth; 23 and while being reviled, He did not revile in return; while suffering, He uttered no threats, but kept entrusting Himself to Him who judges righteously;

I John 3:2 NIV


