"And you people of **Capernaum**, will you be honored in heaven? No, you will go down to the place of the dead. For if the miracles I did for you had been done in wicked Sodom, it would still be here today." (11:23)

Jesus had only moved approximately 20 miles from his home town of Nazareth to a fishing town called Capernaum.

BUT he who is least in the ______ is greater than he" (11:11)! "To what can I compare this generation? It is like children playing a game in the public square. They complain to their friends, 'We played wedding songs, and you didn't dance, so we played funeral songs, and you didn't mourn'." (11:16-17) "For John didn't spend his time eating and drinking, and you say, 'He's possessed by a demon.' The Son of Man, on the other hand, feasts and drinks, and you say, 'He's a glutton and a drunkard, and a friend of tax collectors and other sinners!' But wisdom is shown to be right by its results." (11:18-19) Three things disciples MUST LEARN about the nature of mankind: 1) You can't be a _____ – they're too fickle; 2) People _____ always meet your expectations about dancing or mourning; 3) If they they will criticize you. After Jesus gives thanks to the Father He states a key truth "My Father has entrusted everything to me. No one truly knows the Son except the Father, and no one truly knows the Father except the Son **and those to whom the Son** *to him."* (Matt. 11:27).
