

“Jesus Models Kingdom Authority” APP Notes

Remember Jesus came to establish a _____; a New Rule; HE IS THE KING of this KINGDOM. **Bible trivia:** out of sixty-six books of the Bible only three use the term “Kingdom” more than 19 times. **The three:** Daniel (43); Luke (45); Matthew (53)!

Kingdom language Pastor Daniel used last week (Chapter 8):

1. Jesus has **authority** over sickness
2. Jesus has **authority** to call disciples
3. Jesus has **authority** over nature
4. Jesus has **authority** over fear
5. Jesus has **authority** over demons

Today we see in Matthew 9 specific examples of these truths:

6. He heals a paralytic: 9:1-8 (same story as Mark 2:1-12). **Key verse (8):**
“When the crowds saw it, they were afraid, and they glorified God, who had given such _____ to men.” **Vs. 7** Jesus had just said, “Son of Man has authority on earth to forgive sins.”
7. He called Levi (tax collector: Matthew) who invited his friends: 9:9-13. **Key verses (9:11b-13):** Pharisees ask, “Why does your teacher eat with tax collectors and sinners?” But when he heard it, he said, “Those who are well have no need of a _____, but those who are sick. Go and learn what this means: ‘I desire mercy, and not sacrifice.’ For I came not to call the righteous, but sinners.”
8. Jesus explains spiritual things with natural things (9:14-17). **Key Verse (17):**
“Neither is new wine put into old wineskins. If it is, the skins burst and the wine is spilled and the skins are destroyed. But _____ is put into fresh wineskins, and so both are preserved.”
9. Faith heals a long-term illness & raises a girl from the dead 9:18-26 (also Mark 5:21-43): **Key verses:**
 - a. A ruler [Jairus] asked Jesus, “My daughter has just died, but come and lay your hand on her, and she will live.” (9:18)

- b. Jesus arrives at the Rulers [Jairus'] home [Mk 5:37 "do not fear, _____
_____]: "But when the crowd had been put outside, he went in
and took her by the hand, and the girl arose." (9:25)

*****A woman interrupted Jesus in his journey to raise the girl*****

- c. A woman repeated to herself, "... 'If I only touch his garment, I will be
made well.' Jesus turned, and seeing her he said, 'Take heart, daughter;
_____ has made you well.' And instantly the woman was
made well." (9:21-22; also Mark 5:30, 34 Virtue/Power OR faith?)
10. blind men asked Jesus to give them sight: "Jesus said to them, 'Do you
_____ that I am able to do this? They said to him, 'Yes, Lord.' Then he
touched their eyes, saying, 'According to your _____ be it done to you.' And
their eyes were opened."
11. Jesus casts demons out of a deaf man (9:32-34) **Key Verse:** "BUT the But the
Pharisees said, "He casts out demons by the prince of demons." (9:34 – in
Matt 12:25 Jesus said, "a house divided against itself cannot stand")!
12. As Jesus brings the KINGDOM He also commissions His Disciples {us
included} to carry the Kingdom to suffering humanity:
- a. "Jesus went...teaching...and proclaiming the _____ **of the kingdom** and
healing every disease and every affliction among the people" (4:23)
- b. Keynote Verse for Matthew series: "Your **kingdom** come, your will be
done, on earth as it is in heaven" (6:10). The Kingdom battle is a _____
_____ [or "will nots"]. Gethsemane (Matt. 26:36-45)
- c. **Jesus prays for laborers LIKE YOU to "Bring God's Healing Love to
Hurting People":**
Matthew 9:35-38 "Jesus went throughout all the cities and villages,
teaching in their synagogues and **proclaiming the gospel of the
kingdom and healing every disease and every affliction**. When he saw
the crowds, he had compassion for them, because they were harassed
and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd. **Then he said to his
disciples**, "The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are
few; therefore, pray earnestly to the Lord of the harvest to send out
laborers into his harvest."

The word "Kingdom" is used 12 times in these sermon notes

The word "Authority" is used 7 times

The words "Believe" OR "Faith" are used 6 times

A “New Kingdom” Prayer for You (from the Living Bible):
