Life on Mission #3: "Come Follow Me"

I had a farmer in Alabama who said to me, "I am getting 50 cents on the dollar supporting the Jesus Film oversees. Why are we spending all this money on church?" I asked him, "You raise cows, right? Does it cost more to have a cow or to raise a cow?" To which he responded, "Oh, it costs a LOT MORE to raise one!" I said, "Well, there's your answer!"

Lessons from Yoda [from significant quotes]:

- 1. Listen to wise leaders: "Hear you nothing that I say?"
- 2. "You must unlearn what you have learned!"
- 3. "No...TRY NOT! DO...or DO NOT; there is NO TRY"

A great disciple-making Pastor Bob Thune preached at Church 212°. He asked, "How's Business." Pastor Bob's (and our) Scriptural Text: "He [Jesus] told his disciples, 'I have been given all authority in heaven and earth. Therefore go and make disciples in all the nations,

[b] baptizing them into the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, 20 and then teach these new disciples to obey all the commands I have given you; and be sure of this—that I am with you always, even to the end of the world'." (Matthew 28:18-20 TLB)

He reminded us that "Going, baptizing, teaching" are three important components to <u>disciple-making</u>.

Christian disciple defined: a dedicated follower of Jesus; follow His teachings; a learner or disciplined one.

"John was there again with <u>two of his disciples</u>. He saw Jesus walking by. John said, 'Look! The Lamb of God!' The two disciples heard him say this. So, <u>they followed Jesus</u>. Then <u>Jesus</u> turned around and <u>saw them following</u>. He asked, 'What do you want?' They said, 'Rabbi, where are you staying?' <u>Rabbi means Teacher</u>. 'Come', he replied. 'You will see.'

So, they went and saw where he was staying. <u>They spent the rest of the day with him</u>" (John 1:35 - 39 NIRV)

Marks of a Disciple of Jesus:

- Discipleship begins when we acknowledge HIM AS THE LAMB OF GOD
- Discipleship continues when we agree to FOLLOW HIM
- Discipleship accelerates when we accept HIM AS TEACHER
- Discipleship enriches us when we go after HIM JUST TO SPEND TIME WITH HIM

"He [Jesus] climbed a mountain and invited those he wanted with him. They climbed together...The plan was that they would be with him, and he would send them out to proclaim the Word" (Mark 3:13-14 MSG).

Jesus, not only commissioned US to make Disciples, HE also practiced Discipleship when he said, "Follow me...".

His call to be a disciple included:

- 1. He calls us to be fishers of men
- 2. He calls us to self-denial
- 3. He calls us to leave distractions AND excuses behind
- 4. He calls us out of darkness and into His Light
- 5. He calls us to serve Him and serve others
- 6. He calls us to follow His Voice: The Voice of our Shepherd

Jesus' Call to Us Today: "<u>Come to Me</u>, all you who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. <u>Take My yoke</u> upon you and <u>learn from Me</u>, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For My yoke is easy and My burden is light."

What if I've followed BUT I failed? Remember Peter's re-invitation: "Follow Me...You Follow Me" (John 21:15 - 22)
