2. The source of everything (emotion, belief, action and habit begin's with a seed of thought. **Mark 4:26-29**

(Seed – A seed not Planted dies unborn)

3. One God-honoring thought has the potential to change the trajectory of both history and eternity.

17 When Moses sent them to explore Canaan, he said, “Go up through the Negev and on into the hill country. 18 See what the land is like and whether the people who live there are strong or weak, few or many. 19 What kind of land do they live in? Is it good or bad? What kind of towns do they live in? Are they unwalled or fortified? 20 How is the soil? Is it fertile or poor? Are there trees in it or not? Do your best to bring back some of the fruit of the land.” **Numbers 13**

4. Joshua and Caleb had a different spirit (Thought - Emotion – Belief – Action)

30 But Caleb tried to quiet the people as they stood before Moses. “Let’s go at once to take the land,” he said. “We can certainly conquer it!”

31 But the other men who had explored the land with him disagreed. “We can’t go up against them! They are stronger than we are!” 32 So they spread this bad report about the land among the Israelites: “The land we traveled through and explored will devour anyone who goes to live there. All the people we saw were huge. 33 We even saw giants there, the descendants of Anak. Next to them we felt like grasshoppers, and that’s what they thought, too!”

A. The people rebel

B. Moses & Aaron prayed

C. Caleb & Joshua son of Nun tore their clothes for truth
