Communion Service:

I Peter 1:18-21 NIRV: "<u>You were set free</u> from an empty way of life. This way of life was handed down to you by your own people of long ago. You know that <u>you</u> <u>were not bought with things that can pass away</u>, like silver or gold. Instead, <u>you</u> <u>were bought with the priceless blood of Christ</u>. He is a perfect lamb. He doesn't have any flaws at all. He was chosen before God created the world...<u>Because of</u> <u>what Christ has done, you believe in God</u>. <u>It was God</u> who raised him from the dead. And <u>it was God</u> who gave him glory. So <u>your faith and hope are in God</u>."

What Communion Celebrates:

- 1. Freedom from our old way of life
- 2. Celebrate the work of the Blood of Christ
- 3. Because of what God has done through Christ "our faith & hope are in God"

Find Freedom #3: Freedom In Truth

Since we live in "community" with other people we tend to compare & measure ourselves with others.

Secular psychologist Thomas Harris' 1967 book: "I'm OK, You're OK" identified 4 ways in which we may relate:

- 1. I'm Not OK, You're OK (inferior position)
- 2. I'm Not OK, You're Not OK (both of us are bad)
- 3. I'm OK, You're Not OK (superior position)
- 4. I'm OK, You're OK (we're both good)

What is the truth? The bible teaches that #2 is true BEFORE Christ, "I'm not OK, You're not OK" (Rom. 3:23). But AFTER Christ #4 is correct, "I'm OK, You're OK" (2 Cor. 5:17). But proceed with caution; DO NOT resort to #3, "I'm OK, You're NOT OK" (Gal. 6:1-5)!

Pastor Daniel used two quotes from Tim Chester two weeks ago in week one in our series about freedom:

"<u>Justification</u> is a change of my status in God's sight; <u>sanctification</u> is a change of my heart and character." He also quoted, "<u>Holiness</u> doesn't happen with great heroic acts, but <u>in 1,000 small decisions</u>." Tim Chester

Pastor Stephanie reminded us last week, *"We believe that <u>life change happens in</u> <u>the context of relationship</u>." She quoted Paul Tripp, <i>"we are all people in <u>need of</u>* <u>change</u>, <u>helping people</u> in need of <u>change</u>."

Four Major Change Agents God Uses to Change Us That Leads Us Into Freedom:

- 1. The Blood of Christ (today's celebration thru Communion)
- 2. The Spirit of Christ (discussed in 1 Cor. 2:9-16 "Know God")
- 3. The Community of Christ (Church: weekend/Life Groups)
- 4. The Word of Christ OR our subtitle: "Freedom In Truth"

Jesus' Prayer for us John 17:13-16 J. B. Phillips Translation: "And now I come to you and I say these things in the world that these men may find my joy completed in themselves. <u>I have given them your word</u>, and the world has hated them, for <u>they are no more sons of the world than I am</u>. I am not praying that you will take them out of the world but that you will <u>keep them from the evil one</u>."

John 17:17-19 Phillips "They are no more the sons of the world than I am—<u>make</u> <u>them holy by the truth</u>; for <u>your word is the truth</u>. I have sent them to the world just as you sent me to the world and I consecrate myself for their sakes that <u>they</u> <u>may be made holy by the truth</u>."

"<u>Christ...loved the church</u> and gave Himself for her, that He might <u>sanctify</u> and <u>cleanse</u> her with the <u>washing of water by the word</u>, that He might <u>present her to</u> <u>Himself a glorious church</u>, not having spot or wrinkle or any such thing, but that she should be <u>holy and without blemish</u>." (Eph. 5:25b-27 NKJV).

John 8:31-33 "Then Jesus said to those Jews who <u>believed Him</u>, '<u>If you abide in</u> <u>My word</u>, you are My disciples indeed. And <u>you shall know the truth</u>, and <u>the</u> <u>truth shall make you free</u>.' They answered Him, 'We are Abraham's descendants, and have never been in bondage to anyone. How can You say, 'You will be made free'?"

John 8:34-36 "Jesus answered them, 'Most assuredly, I say to you, whoever commits sin is a slave of sin. And a slave does not abide in the house forever, but <u>a</u> <u>son abides forever</u>. Therefore, <u>if the Son makes you free, you shall be free</u> <u>indeed</u>'."

James 1:21-23 KJV "Wherefore <u>lay apart</u> all filthiness and superfluity of naughtiness, and <u>receive with meekness the engrafted word</u>, which is able to save your souls. <u>But be ye doers of the word</u>, and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves. For if any be a hearer of the word, and not a doer, he is like unto a man beholding his natural face in a glass:

James 1:24-25 KJV "For he beholds himself, and goes his way, and straightway forgets what manner of man he was. But whoso <u>looks</u> into the perfect law of liberty, and <u>continues</u> therein, he being not a forgetful hearer, but a <u>doer</u> of the work, this man <u>shall be blessed in his deed</u>."

- 4. What is the result of walking in the truth?
- 5. Read James 1:21-25 & briefly discuss what next steps you can take in knowing and walking in the truth
