

Week 4: Enjoy The Promise of Submission

Reading

Before you dive into the text, begin with prayer. Invite God to show you truths from the text and disciplines you can practice. Take your time through the Scriptures. Read them slowly, thoughtfully, humbly, prayerfully, and practically.

If you are new to reading the Bible, we recommend choosing a version like the New International Version (NIV) or New Living Translation (NLT). We also recommend the YouVersion Bible reading app.

Read 1 Peter 3:1-7

2 Questions for Singles:

1. Read 1 Cor 7:32-40: what are some benefits to your being single? Are you making the most out of your singleness according to this passage?
 Read Acts 4:18-20. Discuss what would be your response if governmental authorities commanded you NOT to speak about Christ.

2 Questions for Married Couples:
1. Individually, itemize which thoughts have prevented you from fulfilling your heavenly charge and promise to submit. Confess these areas of fear to God, turn from them and prepare how you will respond to them when these fears come upon you. Be intentional about this plan.

charge and yielded to peace? Share this. Encourage one another in this.
