

“I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me.”

(Please commit yourself to memorize this verse) this truth only applies to the redeemed

1. I am Crucified - Read Romans 6:3-11. A \_\_\_\_\_ action, not progressive; a present certainty of results!
  - A. Paul’s knowledge & \_\_\_\_\_ about this doctrine must be our’s, too.
  - B. Every believer is truly dead, united with Christ in his crucifixion; sin and the law have no \_\_\_\_\_ over you.
  - C. Just as Paul’s \_\_\_\_\_ united him to Christ, first in his death, so it is with each of us who are saved.
  - D. We found God’s only \_\_\_\_\_ sacrifice for our sins in Jesus Christ, and it wasn’t in our ability to perform. (Isaiah 53:11)
2. With Christ - Romans 6:8. \_\_\_\_\_ speaking, God placed you in Christ by the Holy Spirit (this is the doctrinal truth about the “Baptism of the Holy Spirit”, see also Eph. 4:5, 1 Cor. 12:12-13) the moment you asked for his salvation and to God it is as if you died on a physical cross and physically arose from the dead as a New Person (not a New \_\_\_\_\_)
  - E. \_\_\_\_\_ baptism is the outward profession of the symbolism of the spiritual new birth; that is why it is commonly referred to as believer’s baptism and is only for one who has by faith received the Lord Jesus Christ as their personal Saviour.
3. Nevertheless I live - Just as Christ’s death is the believer’s, so is Christ’s Life!
  - F. We are resurrected with Christ, free from sin’s power and \_\_\_\_\_ of living for God.
4. Yet not I, but Christ liveth in me - Read John 15:1-8. Will you so \_\_\_\_\_?
5. The life I now live in the flesh - Saul was self-righteous & proud & self-centered; Paul was Christ-righteous, humble, & Christ-centered.
  - G. Though our life after salvation is still lived \_\_\_\_\_ this flesh, it is not to be lived \_\_\_\_\_ the flesh.
  - H. It’s an \_\_\_\_\_ life! \_\_\_\_\_ is our life (Colossians 1:27, 3:4) & you cannot imitate God (Satan tried, “I will be \_\_\_\_\_ the most High” Isaiah 14:14). Side note: modern versions literally use imitate in teaching the Christian life, another proof that their spirit behind them is not the Holy Spirit!
  - I. It is never us trying to act how Christ would act in any situation, but the \_\_\_\_\_ of the New Life (Christ) in me and my \_\_\_\_\_ & \_\_\_\_\_ of body, soul, and spirit to the Holy Spirit’s every command. (Romans 6:12-13; Romans 8)
6. I live by the faith of the son of God - Who has more faith, \_\_\_\_ or \_\_\_\_\_?
  - J. Jesus kept all the law, all the time, perfectly. I still can’t, nor does God put me under it. A holy life is commanded by God for us, but it’s BY him.

- K. He does command me to “walk in the Spirit” and in my \_\_\_\_\_ submission to so live I will be found living victorious over sin’s power and free from legalistic systems to appease myself or someone else’s ideas of Christianity (See Galatians 3)
- 7. Who loved me and gave himself for me - Why do you read the Bible, Pray, Come to Church Services?
  - L. Motivated by \_\_\_\_\_, or \_\_\_\_\_ (& \_\_\_\_\_ love)? See Jude vs 21.
  - M. God seeks to transform us from “\_\_\_\_\_” unto “\_\_\_\_\_”
  - N. Paul has no qualms of stating boldly that he is loved by God. This must be your boldness, your testimony, too, or you will be destined for defeat at the hands of the Accuser. Ask yourself if you can boldly declare this. If not, do you know why? I would be glad to help if you wish.

Don’t just agree with the verse, Believe It! \_\_\_\_\_

Look at the entire context of the book of Galatians. A New Testament church receiving and believing false doctrine and turning against the apostle Paul, and thus Christ their Saviour. It’s God’s love to correct them by reminding them of the truth of the grace of God apart from the Law of Moses and the life of Christ verses the deadness of the Law. A Legalistic Life is a Dead Life! The flesh (the old, sinful Adamic nature) cannot please God; it has to die. Christ died our death for us so that we may live unto God. It is Christ’s vicarious death and glorious life that we live by.

What does the realization of this verse mean to you now? It will help you if you write out your thoughts. \_\_\_\_\_  
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
