Colossians 2:2-4 CSB

[2] I want their hearts to be encouraged and joined together in love, so that they may have all the riches of complete understanding and have the knowledge of God's mystery-Christ. [3] In him are hidden all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge. [4] I am saying this so that no one will deceive you with arguments that sound reasonable.

Colossians 2:16-17 CSB

[16] Therefore, don't let anyone judge you in regard to food and drink or in the matter of a festival or a new moon or a Sabbath day. [17] These are a shadow of what was to come; the substance is Christ.

Romans 14:5 CSB

[5] One person judges one day to be more important than another day. Someone else judges every day to be the same. Let each one be fully convinced in his own mind.

Transition from God to LORD God

God-Elohim-One God supplemented with plurality in verbs. Plurality in One. (Deuteronomy 6:4)

LORD-(Jewish word Adonai means Lord to avoid saying YHWH out of extreme reverence) YHWH (YAHWEH with assumed vowels)

YHWH is God's personally revealed name as the covenant keeping God. The promise keeping God. God created.

Specifically, specially, personally, intimately, YHWH

Exodus 3:11-15-Moses commissioned by YHWH

When man appears on the scene God appears also in a different character. He now appears under the title of Jehovah (YAHWEH), which means essentially the covenant-making God, the God who keeps a promise. It is particularly significant that when God first reveals himself to this race of ours, it is as a God who intends to keep his promises. -Ray Stedman

5] no shrub of the field had yet grown on the land, and no plant of the field had yet sprouted, for the LORD God had not made it rain on the land, and there was no man to work the ground.

This is an understanding of how the earth was before sin entered.

No weeds.

No grain (barley, wheat, etc.)

No rain (until the flood)

No tilling of the soil by man to produce grains.

No Adam (man) to work the Adama (ground)

Work before sin vs. work after the fall. Genesis 3:17-19

6] But mist would come up from the earth and water all the ground.

Literally a flow of water, subterranean springs would overflow onto the ground to water everything.

Consistent, unlike the rain during and after the flood.

7] Then the LORD God formed the man out of the dust from the ground and breathed the breath of life into his nostrils, and the man became a living being.

-YHWH Elohim (personal and covenant name)

-Formed from the earth-formed like an artist or potter

Potter and clay
