Recap of Genesis 1:1-2 & 1:3-5

- Before the foundation of the World-all of Trinity planning salvation
- Jesus, God the Son, is the Creator (John 1, Colossians 1, Hebrews 1, I Corinthians 8:6) along with God The Holy Spirit and God the Father
- Jesus is repeatedly described as the Light and no sun or moon needed in the next new creation-Revelation.

Hebrews 11:3,6 CSB

[3] By faith we understand that the universe was created by the word of God, so that what is seen was made from things that are not visible. [6] Now without faith it is impossible to please God, since the one who draws near to him must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who seek him.

1 Corinthians 8:6 CSB

[6] yet for us there is one God, the Father. All things are from him, and we exist for him. And there is one Lord, Jesus Christ. All things are through him, and we exist through him.

Day 2. Upper water, lower water and sky

Genesis 1:6-8

Separating lower water from upper water-antediluvian atmosphere. (vs. postdiluvian)  
Seas and upper atmosphere around earth surrounded by water.

Jesus speaking of Himself and the analogy of a seed

John 12:23-28 CSB

Seed-mortal to immortal. Physical to spiritual.

I Corinthians 15:35-58

Not a coincidence that seeds were a priority on the third day of creation.

Seed has life and new and multiplying life in it, like Jesus and like Jesus in us.

Jesus as solid rock, water, seed
