 - What does God promise as a result?
 - Do you see the irony in God's judgment of the Edomites?
- Reflect on this statement by John Walton, "Prophecy is more important for what it reveals about God than for what it reveals about the future."
 - Do you believe that this is true?
 - How might this influence the way you read the Prophets in the future?
- What does the book of Obadiah reveal about God?
- Why is pride such a big deal to God?
- Do you struggle with pride? If so, how?
- Reflect on these statements by John Stott, "Pride isn't just the first of the 'seven deadly sins,' it is itself the essence of all sin" and "Pride is our greatest enemy and humility our greatest friend."
- Read James 4:6 and Philippians 2:3-11
 - How will looking to Jesus help us with our pride?
 - What does it mean to "preach the gospel to yourself?"
